In re Vacation of Portion of
Pasqualito Avenue and Oak Street }
Alhambra Road District }
Petition of J. A. Graves, et al. }

This being the time regu-
larly set by order of this Board
and publication of notice -

thereof for hearing the petition herein the matter is called up -
and no protest having been filed, and no one appearing to oppose
said vacation;

Upon motion of Supervisor Longden, duly seconded and
carried it is ordered that the following be and the same is
hereby adopted:

Whereas, it appearing to this Board that Pasqualito Ave-
nue, prior to its dedication as a public highway, was laid off
60 feet wide, graded, and the sidewalks curbed, but when the same
was conveyed to the County as a public highway by some error it
was described as being 70 feet wide;

Now, therefore, it is ordered that all of Pasqualito Avenue,
as shown on map of "Property belonging to J. A. Graves" recorded
in Book 52, page 66 Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County,
and the extension of said avenue easterly to Granada Avenue, ex-
cepting therefrom the southeasterly 48 feet of said Pasqualito
Avenue and such portions as lie within the intersection of Stone-
man Avenue, and all of Oak Street from the east line of Wilson
Avenue to a point where the same connects with the northerly line
of Pasqualito Avenue, be and the same are hereby vacated and
abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage.

This order is conditioned upon the petitioners filing for rec-
ord in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County a certified
copy hereof together with a map showing all property affected thereby.
