In re Vacation of Monterey Road }  
Petition of Alice H. Graves, et al. }

This being the time regularly set by order of continuance of this Board for hearing herein the matter is taken up, and no protests having been filed;

Upon motion of Supervisor Longden duly seconded and carried it is ordered that the petition be and the same is hereby granted; and it is further ordered that Monterey Road, from the south line of Wilson Avenue to the north line of Alhambra Road, in the Alhambra Road District, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage.

This order is conditioned upon the right of the County of Los Angeles to enter upon said vacated and abandoned road for the purpose of securing sand and gravel for use upon the public highways of Los Angeles County, and the construction of culverts and bridges connected therewith

And it is further ordered that the petitioners herein file for record in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County a certified copy of this order together with a map showing all property as affected thereby.
