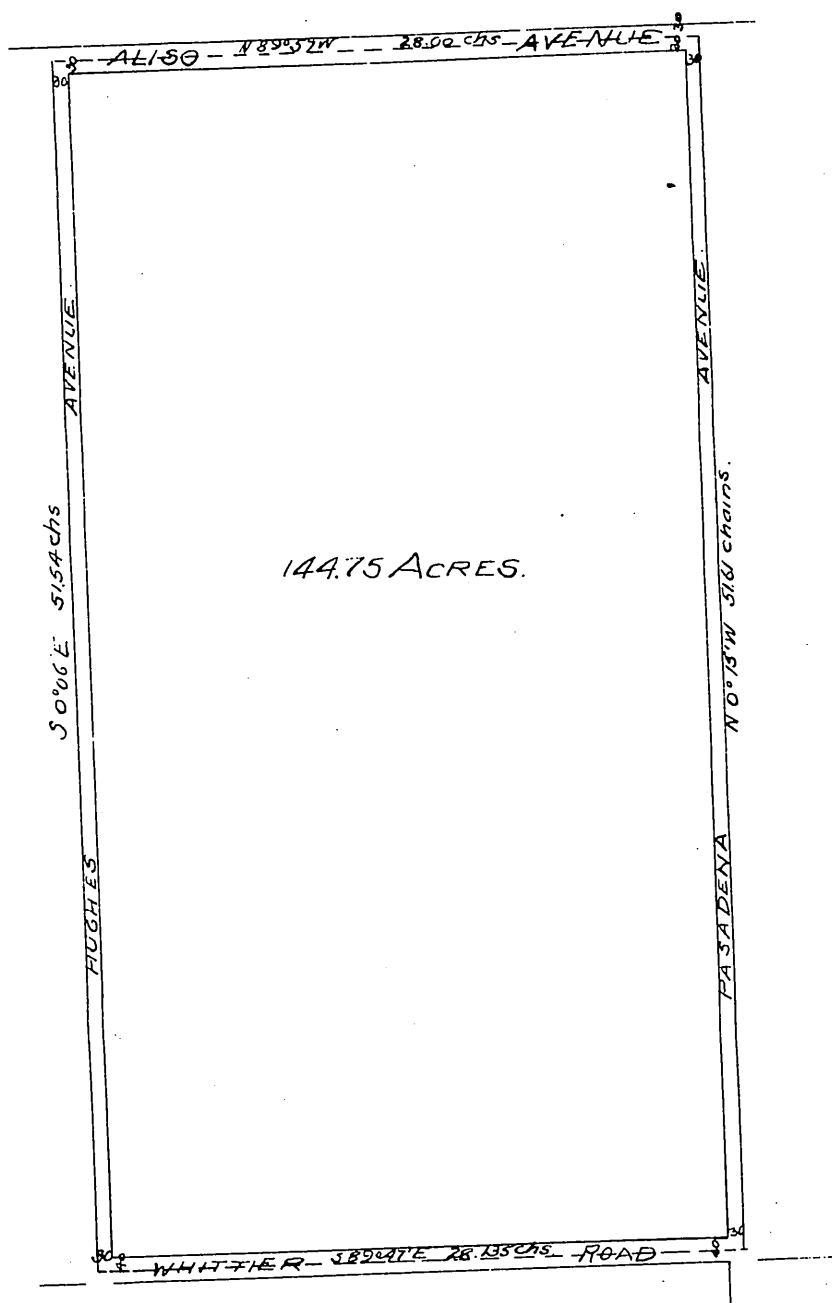


Map of

Scale 5 chains to one inch.

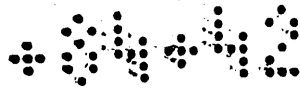

The Board met in regular session pursuant to adjournment. Present, Supervisors E. S. Field, Chairman presiding, Geo. Alexander, O. W. Longden, C. E. Patterson and P. J. Wilson, and C. W. Bell, Clerk by R. Williams deputy.

In re vacation of Streets  
in the Gephard Tract  
Fruitland Road District

This being the time regularly set by order of this Board, and publication of notice thereof for hearing herein, the matter is called up and John F. Hughes as the representative of Mrs. Laura S. Hughes appears and protests against the closing of the thirty (30) foot road on the west side of said tract; and no other protest having been presented, upon motion of Supervisor Longden, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered... that the said petition be and the same is hereby granted in part, to wit: All that portion of the unnamed street or road running north and south through the center of said tract from the south line of Aliso Avenue to the north line of East Second Street; also all that portion of three unnamed streets running east and west through said tract from the west line of a thirty (30) foot road on the east side of said tract to the east line of the thirty (30) foot road on the west side of said tract, and the said unnamed streets and roads are hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage.

This order is conditioned upon the petitioner filing for record in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County, a certified copy hereof, together with a map showing all property affected thereby.
