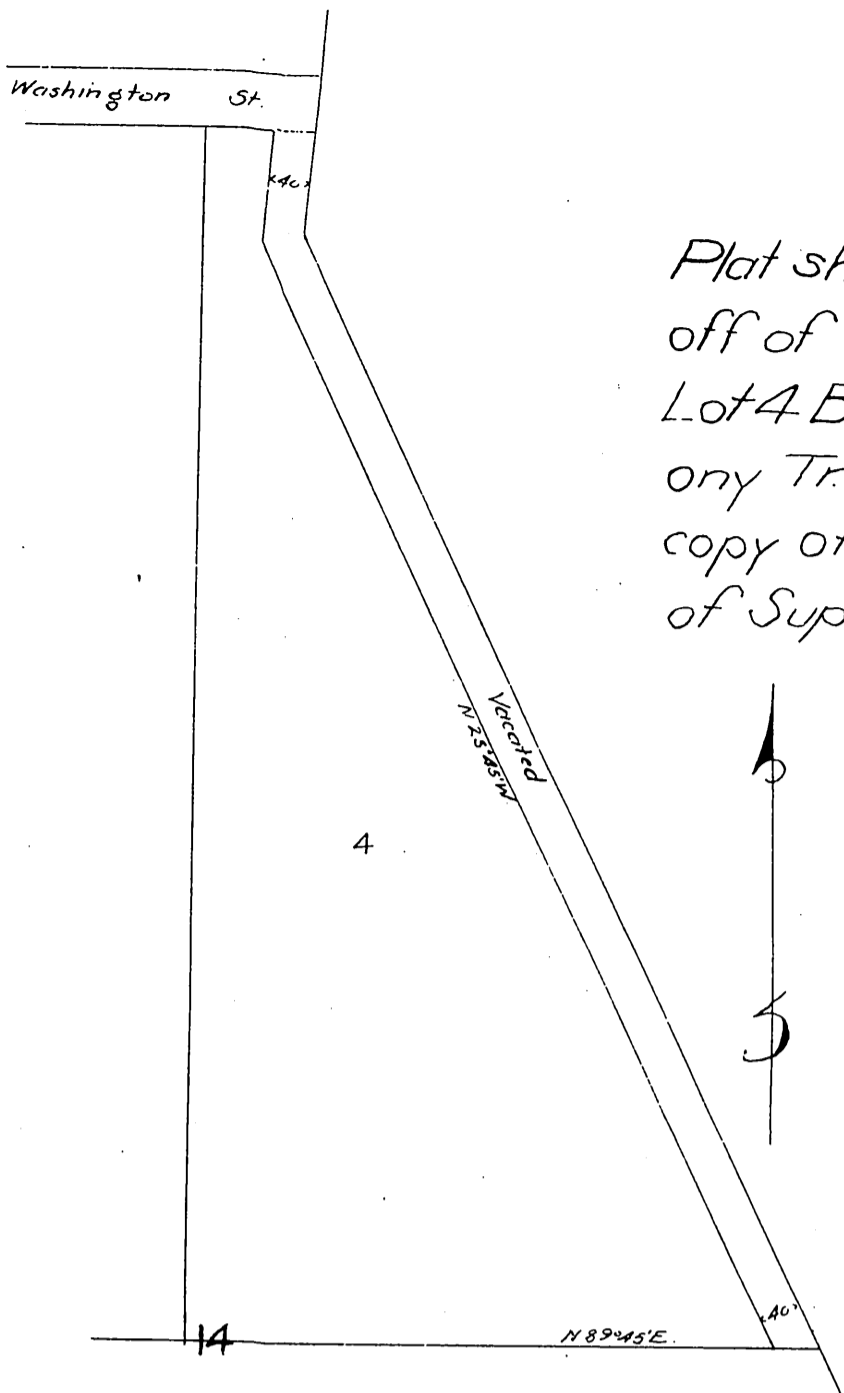

This matter heretofore taken under advisement, to-wit: June 18, 1901, the matter is called up, and upon motion of Supervisor Wilson, duly seconded... and carried, it is ordered that all that certain road deeded to Los Angeles County by Charles Dupont, to-wit: the east forty (40) feet of Lot four (4) Block fourteen (14) in the California Co. Operative Colony Tract, as per deed recorded in Book 1358, page 208 of Deeds, in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage.

This order is conditioned upon the petitioners filing for record in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County a certified copy hereof, together with a map showing all property affected thereby.
