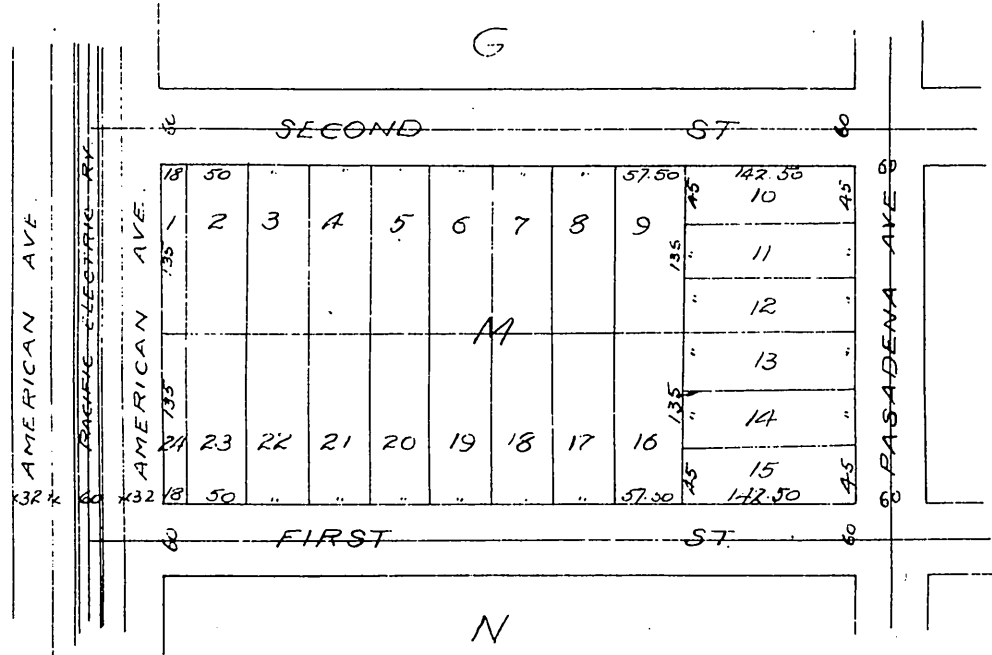


MAP
