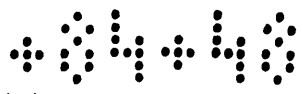


A Replat of

E H ROYCE'S SUBDIVISIONS

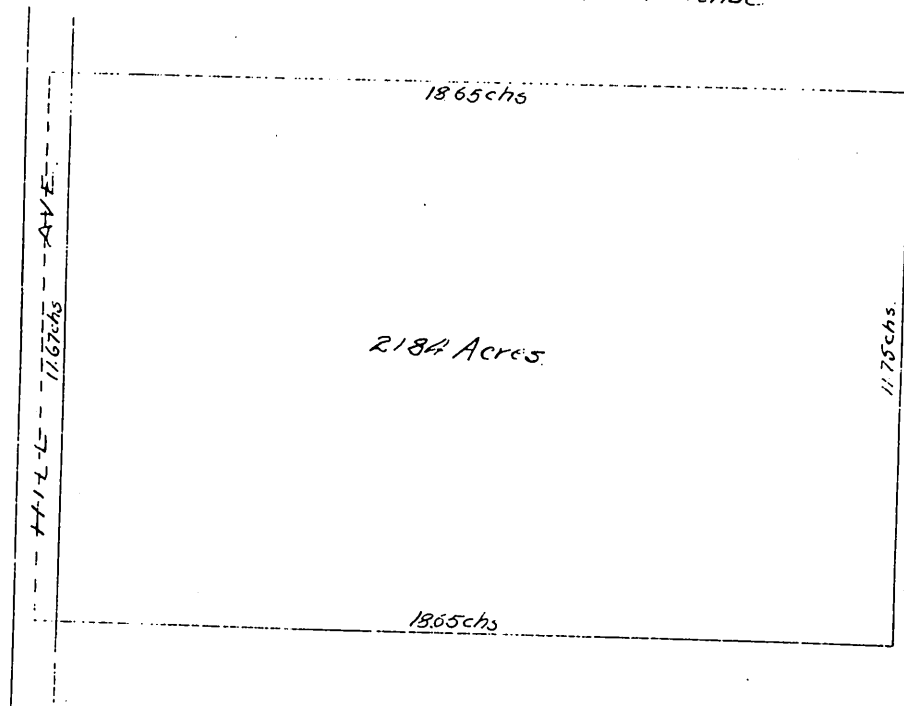

The Board met in regular session pursuant to adjournment Present Supervisors E. S. Field, Chairman presiding Geo Alexander, O. W. Langden, C. E. Patterson and P. J. Wilson, and C. W. Bell, Clerk, by R. Williams, deputy

In re Vacation of Alosta Avenue and other Streets in E. H. Royces Subdivision of a portion of Grogan Tract.

This, being the time regularly set by order of this Board, and publication of notice thereof for

hearing the petition of T. Early, et al, for the vacation and abandonment of Alosta Street, Elsie Street, Halstead Street and Madena Avenue as shown upon the map of E. H. Royce's Subdivision of a part of the Grogan Tract, also that portion of Alosta Street lying north of and adjoining the property of said E. H. Royce, the matter is called up, and no protests having been filed.

Upon motion of Supervisor Langden, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that Alosta Street, Elsie Street, Halstead Street and Madena Avenue, also all that portion of Alosta Street lying north of and adjoining the property of said E. H. Royce be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage.

This order is conditioned upon the petitioners filing for record in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County a certified copy hereof together with a map showing all property as affected thereby.
