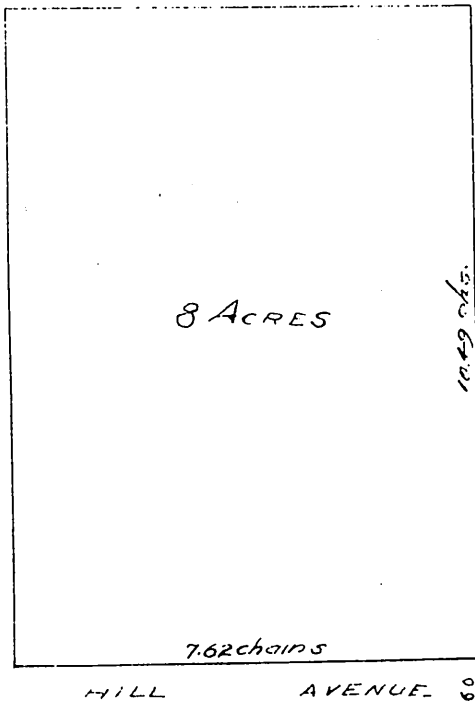

and other streets in E. H. Royce's
Subdivision of a Portion of Grogan Tract

This being the time regu-
larly set by order of this Board

and publication of notice thereof, for hearing the petition of T. Early et al, for
for the vacation and abandonment of Alosta Street, Elsie Street, Halstead
Street and Modena Avenue, as shown upon the map of E. H. Royce's Subdiv-
ision of a part of the Grogan Tract, also that portion of Alosta Street lying
north of and adjoining the property of said E. H. Royce; the matter is call-
ed up, and no protests having been filed.

Upon motion of Supervisor Langden, duly seconded and carried, it is
ordered that Alosta Street, Elsie Street, Halstead Street and Modena Avenue,
also all that portion of Alosta Street lying north of and adjoining the prop-
erty of said E. H. Royce be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned.
and the land therein contained restored to acreage.
