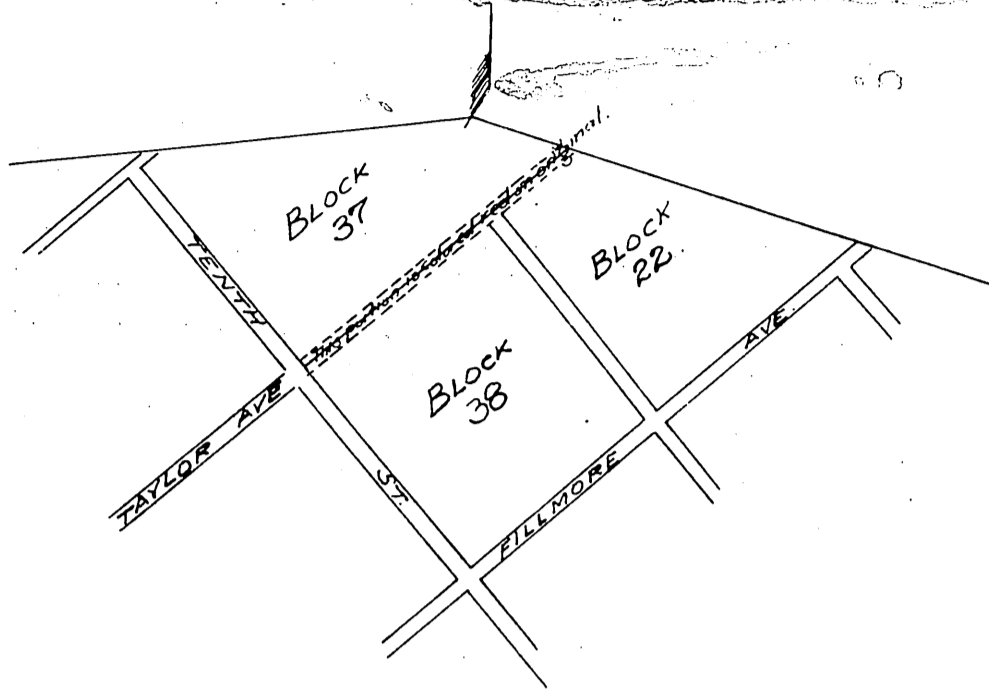


Showing vacation of portion of Taylor Avenue in MacLay Rancho as ordered by Hon Board of Supervisors

The Board met in regular session pursuant to adjournment Present Supervisors E. S. Field, Chairman presiding Geo. Alexander, O W Longden, Chas. E. Patterson, and P. J. Wilson, and C. W. Bell, Clerk, by R. Williams, deputy.

San Fernando Road District.

This being the time regularly set by order of this

Board, and publication of notice thereof, for hearing the petition of J. A. McCusker et al, for the vacation and abandonment of a portion of Taylor Avenue in San Fernando Road District, the matter is called up, and no protest having been filed, upon motion of Supervisor Patterson, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that Taylor Avenue, from the easterly side of 10th Street northeasterly to the exterior boundary of the MacLay Rancho ex. Mission of San Fernando, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage.

This order is conditioned upon the petitioners filing for record in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County a certified copy hereof together with a map showing all property as affected thereby
