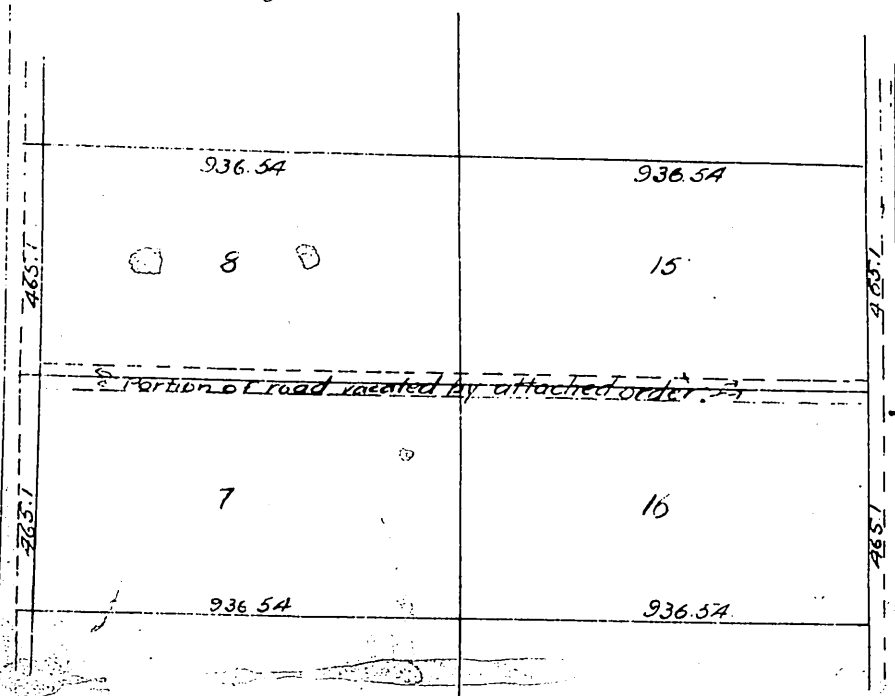

This being the time regularly set by order of this Board and

publication of notice thereof for hearing the petition of N. E. Davison et al, for the vacation of a 50-foot road running east and west between lots 8 and 7 and between lots 15 and 16 of Firey and Rhorer's Subdivision of the Soto Tract as per map recorded in Book 16, page 10 Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, the matter is called up and no protests having been filed, upon motion of Supervisor Longden duly seconded and carried it is ordered that all of that unnamed road lying between lots 8 and 7 and between lots 15 and 16 of Firey and Rhorer's Subdivision of the Soto Tract, as per map recorded in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County in Book 16, page 10 Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage.

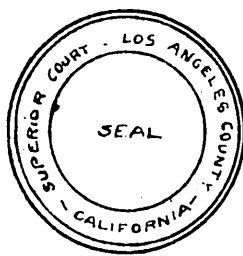
