The Board met in regular session. Present, Supervisors E. S. Field, Chairman presiding, Geo. Alexander, O. W. Longdon, C. E. Puterson, and P. J. Wilson, and C. W. Bell, Clerk, by R. Williams, deputy.

In re Vacation of Roads, Streets and Avenues in MacLay Rancho Ex-Mission de San Fernando

This being the time regularly set by order of this Board and publication of notice thereof for hearing the petition herein, the matter is called up, and no protests having been filed upon motion of Supervisor Patterson, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that 4th Street from Grant Avenue to the southerly line of the MacLay Rancho; 5th street from Grant avenue to the easterly line of the MacLay Rancho; 6th street from Grant Ave. to Dewey avenue, 7th street from Grant avenue to Pendleton avenue, 8th street from Grant avenue to Wicks avenue; 9th street from Hayes avenue to Cleveland avenue; 10th street from Hayes ave to Garfield avenue; also 10 feet on each side of the following named avenues to wit; Grant avenue from San Fernando Road to 11th Street, Hayes avenue from San Fernando Road to 11th Street, Garfield avenue from San Fernando road to 11th street, Arthur avenue from San Fernando road to the east line of the San Fernando Rancho, Cleveland avenue from San Fernando road to the east line of the San Fernando Rancho; Wicks avenue from San Fernando road to the east line of the San Fernando Rancho, James avenue from San Fernando road to the east line of the San Fernando Rancho; Pendleton avenue from 14th street to the east line of the San Fernando Rancho; Plater avenue from the south line of the San Fernando Rancho to the east line of the San Fernando Rancho, Dewey avenue from the south line of the San Fernando Rancho to the east line of the San Fernando Rancho; Pacific avenue from the south line of the San Fernando Rancho, to the east line of the San Fernando Rancho, as shown upon a map of portion of MacLay Rancho recorded in Book 37, page 5 et seq. Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage.
