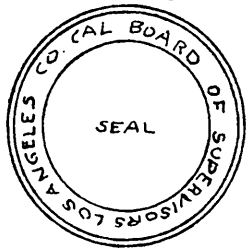
This being the time regularly set by order of this Board and publication of notice thereof for hearing the petition herein, the matter is called up, and a protest having been filed herein signed by the Santa Monica Commercial Co. and nine others, protesting against the granting of the petition herein, and E.A. DeCamp, Esq., representing the petitioners herein, and E.J. Yawter Esq., representing the protestants herein, being present, announce that they have compromised and settled all their differences herein. And upon motion of Supervisor Wilson, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that the following streets lying north of Rose Street in the Ocean Tract in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, to-wit, Soreno Street Sixth Street, Condelario Street, Ballona Ave. and David Avenue as per map of said tract recorded in Book 23, pages 93 and 94, Misc. Records of Los Angeles County, be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage. This order is conditioned upon the petitioners filing for record in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County a certified copy here of together with a map showing all property as affected thereby.
