In re Vacation of Unnamed Streets }  
in Los Robles Park. }  
Petition of Harriet McCord Allen }

This being the time regularly set by order of this board and publication of notice thereof for hearing the application of Harriet McCord Allen, et al. for the vacation and abandonment of an unnamed road and alley in Los Robles Park, the matter is called up. And upon motion of Supervisor Longden duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that all that strip of land heretofore dedicated for public use in part as a road and in part as an alley, as shown on a map of Los Robles Park, recorded in Book 66, pages 39 and 40, Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, and particularly described as follows to wit: Beginning at the North west corner of lot fourteen (14) of Los Robles Park, as shown by said map, thence north forty-two minutes (42') west on the prolongation of the east line of Los Robles Avenue thirty-two (32) feet to the north line of a two (2) foot strip shown on said map and marked "two foot strip reserved," thence along said line north eighty-five degrees (85°) east to the northwest corner of the tract shown on said map and marked "Allendale," thence south fourteen degrees (14°) thirty-one (31) minutes east along the westerly line of Allendale to the southwest corner thereof; thence south eighty-five degrees (85°) west fifteen (15) feet to the southeast corner of lot Nineteen (19) Los Robles Park, thence north fourteen degrees (14°) thirty-one minutes (31') west along the west line of the alley shown by said map as lying east of lots fourteen (14) to nineteen (19) Los Robles Park, to the north east corner of said lot fourteen (14); thence along the north line of said lot south eighty-five degrees (85°) west three hundred six and eighth tenths (306.8) feet to the place of beginning be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage.

This order is conditioned upon the petitioners filing for record in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County a certified copy here of; together with a map showing all property affected thereby.
