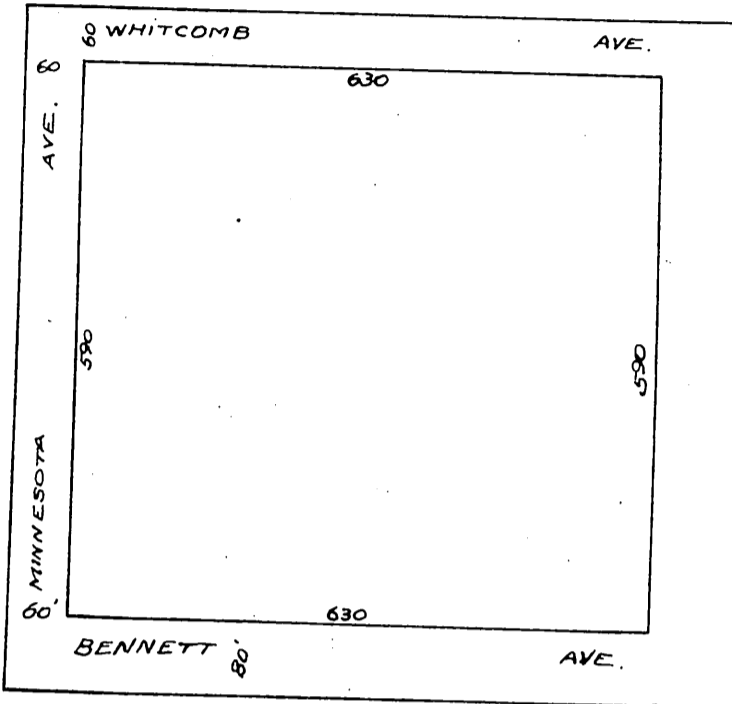

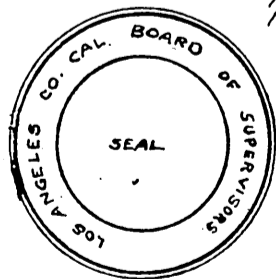
The Board met in regular session, Present, Supervisors E. S. Field, Chairman --

In re-Vacation of Alleys in Block "B"
 in Valley View Addition to the
 Town of Glendora.

This being the time regularly set by order of
 this Board, and publication of notice thereof for hearing the petition herein the mo-
 tion is called up, and no protest having been filed upon motion of Supervisor Lon-
 gden, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that the alleys in Block "B" in the
 Valley View Addition to the Town of Glendora, be and the same are hereby-
 vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage.
 This order is conditioned upon the petitioners filing for record in the office of
 the Recorder of Los Angeles County a certified copy hereof, together with a map
 showing all property as effected thereby.
