
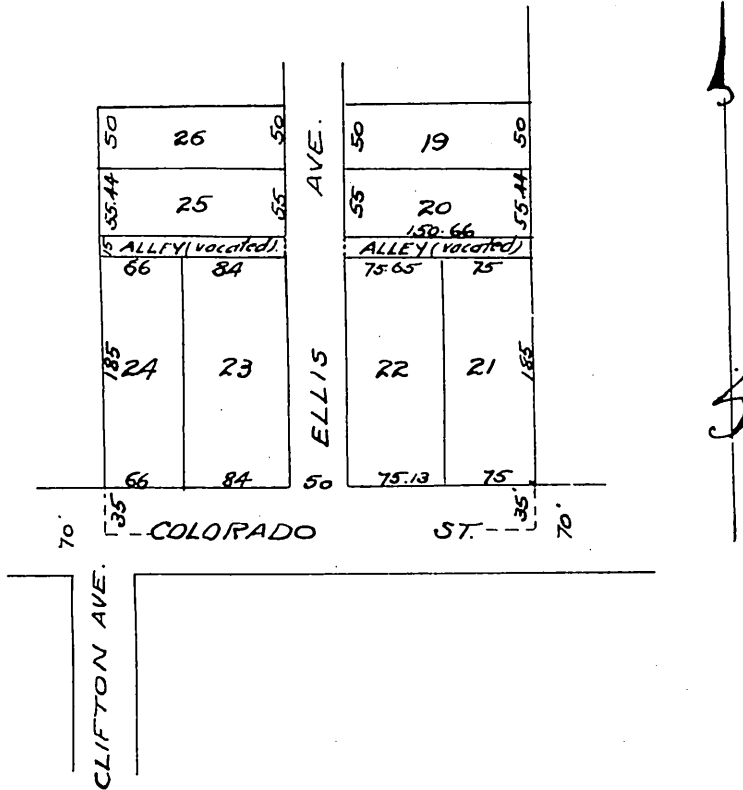


Map of a portion of

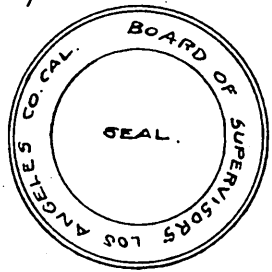
This being the time regularly set by order of


