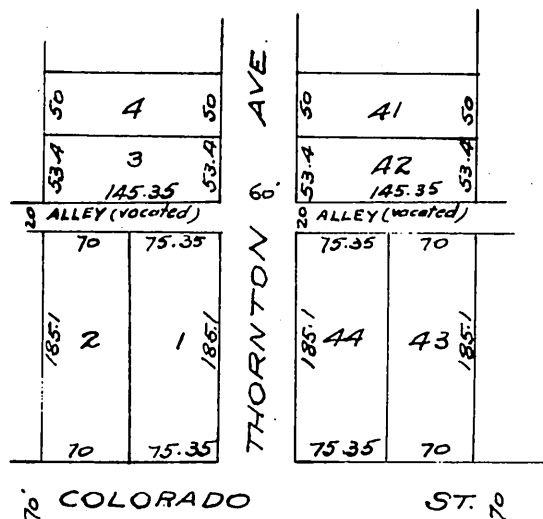


Map of a portion of the

 and 44 of said subdivision as per map recorded in Book 31 page 33
 Misc. Records of Los Angeles County, be and the same is hereby va-
 cated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to--
 acreage. This order is conditioned upon the petitioners filing for
 record in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County, a cer-
 tified copy hereof together with a map showing all property as aff-
 ected thereby.

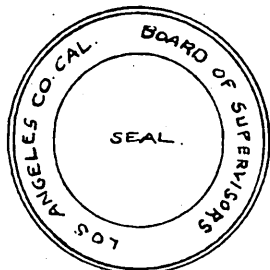
