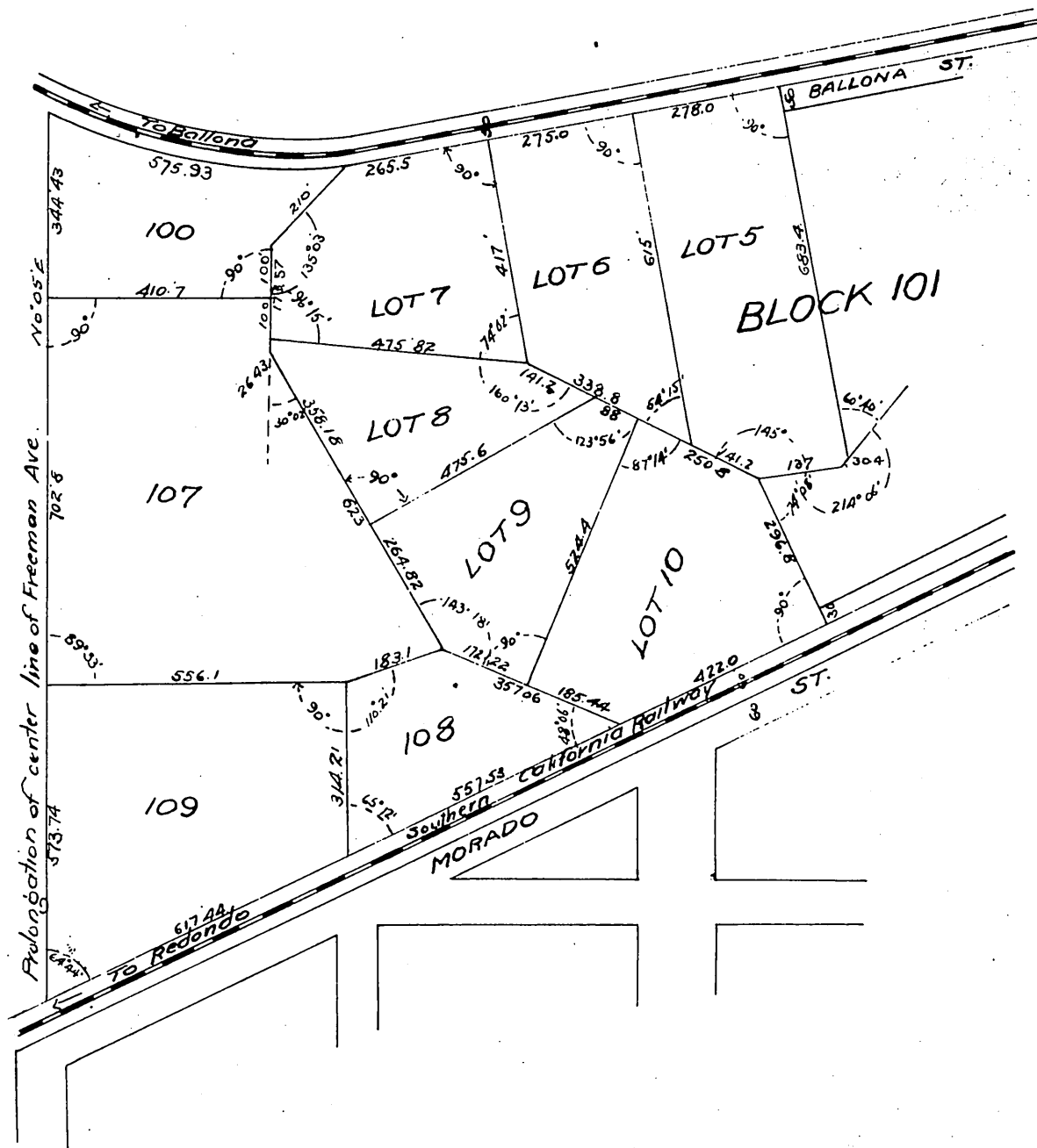
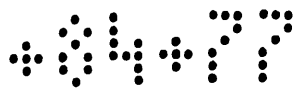


Map of part of the

The Board met in regular session Present Supervisors O. W. Longden, Chair-
 man presiding, Geo. Alexander, A. J. Graham, P. J. Wilson and C. E. Potterson,
 and C. G. Keyes, Clerk, by J. O. Lowe deputy.

In re-Vacation of Streets in }
 the Townsite of Inglewood }
 Centinela Road District }

This being the time regularly set by order of
 this Board, and publication of notice thereof, for hearing the petition herein
 the matter is called up and no protests having been filed, Upon motion of
 Supervisor Wilson, duly seconded and carried, It is Ordered that the follow-
 ing described streets and roads in the Townsite of Inglewood in Centi-
 nela Road District, County of Los Angeles, State of California to-wit;
 Freeman Ave. from the north line of Morado Street to the southerly line
 of right of way of the Santa Monica Division of the Southern California
 Railway; Meadow Street from Freeman avenue to Centinela avenue; Vine
 Street from Freeman avenue to Centinela avenue; Ash avenue from
 Morado street to Vine street; Centinela avenue from Morado street
 to Ballona street; an unnamed street lying between lot 10, Block 101 and the
 railway right of way from Centinela avenue to the easterly line of the said lot
 10, Block 101, an unnamed street forty feet in width lying between the South-
 erly line of Block 109 and the railway right of way; Ballona street from
 Centinela avenue to the easterly line of lot 5, Block 101; according to the
 maps of said townsite recorded in Miscellaneous Records of said Los An-
 geles County, in Book 34, pages 19, et seq. and Book 3A, page 82, be and
 the same are hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein con-
 tained restored to acreage.
