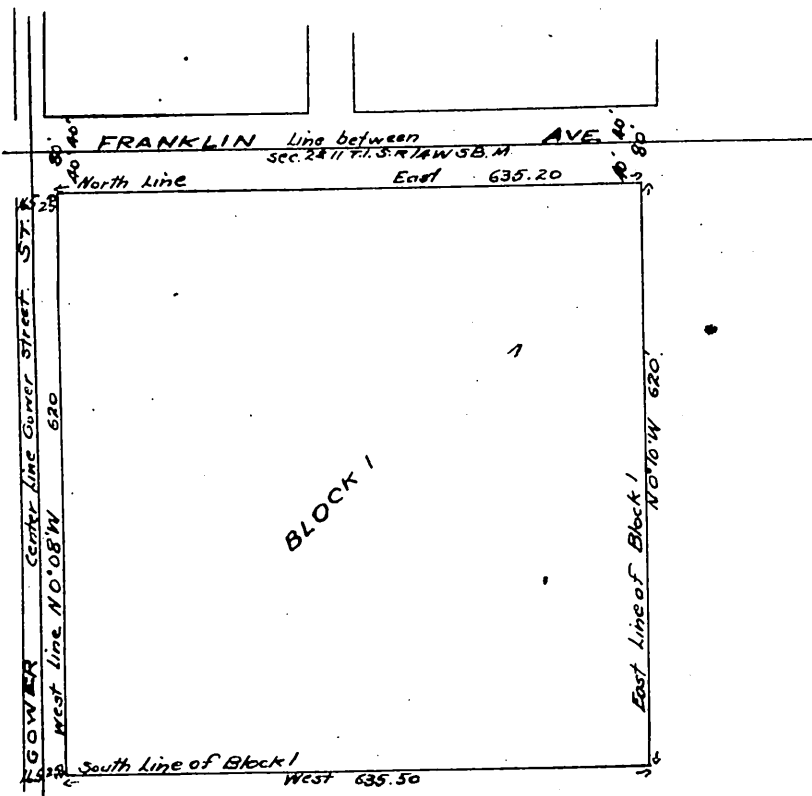




HOLLYWOOD TROPICAL PARK TRACT.
