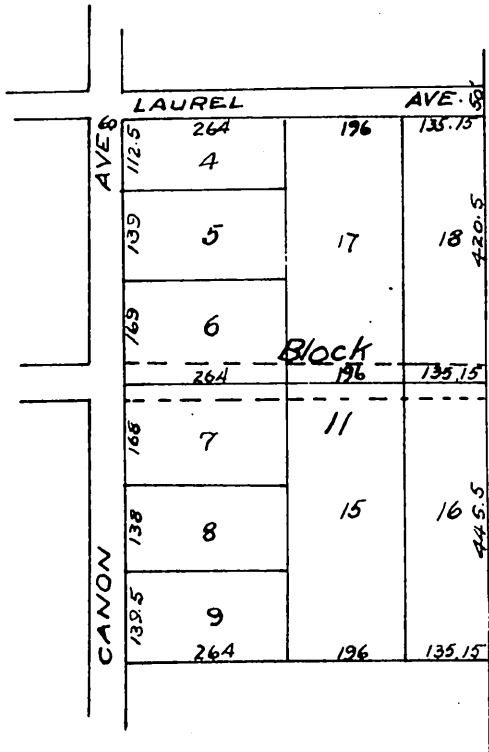


Map of a portion of Block 11

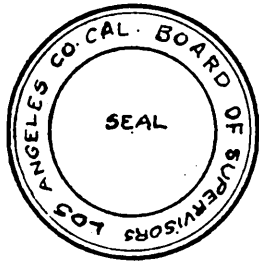

This being the time regularly set by order of this Board and publication of notice thereof, for hearing the petition herein, the matter is called up; and no protests having been filed, Upon motion of Supervisor -- Alexander duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that all that portion of Highland Avenue extending east of the east line of Canon Avenue, in Carter's Vineyard Tract, as per map thereof recorded in Book 36, page 19 Misc. Records of Los Angeles County, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage. This order is conditioned upon the petitioners filing for record in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County a certified copy hereof together with a map showing all lands as affected thereby.
