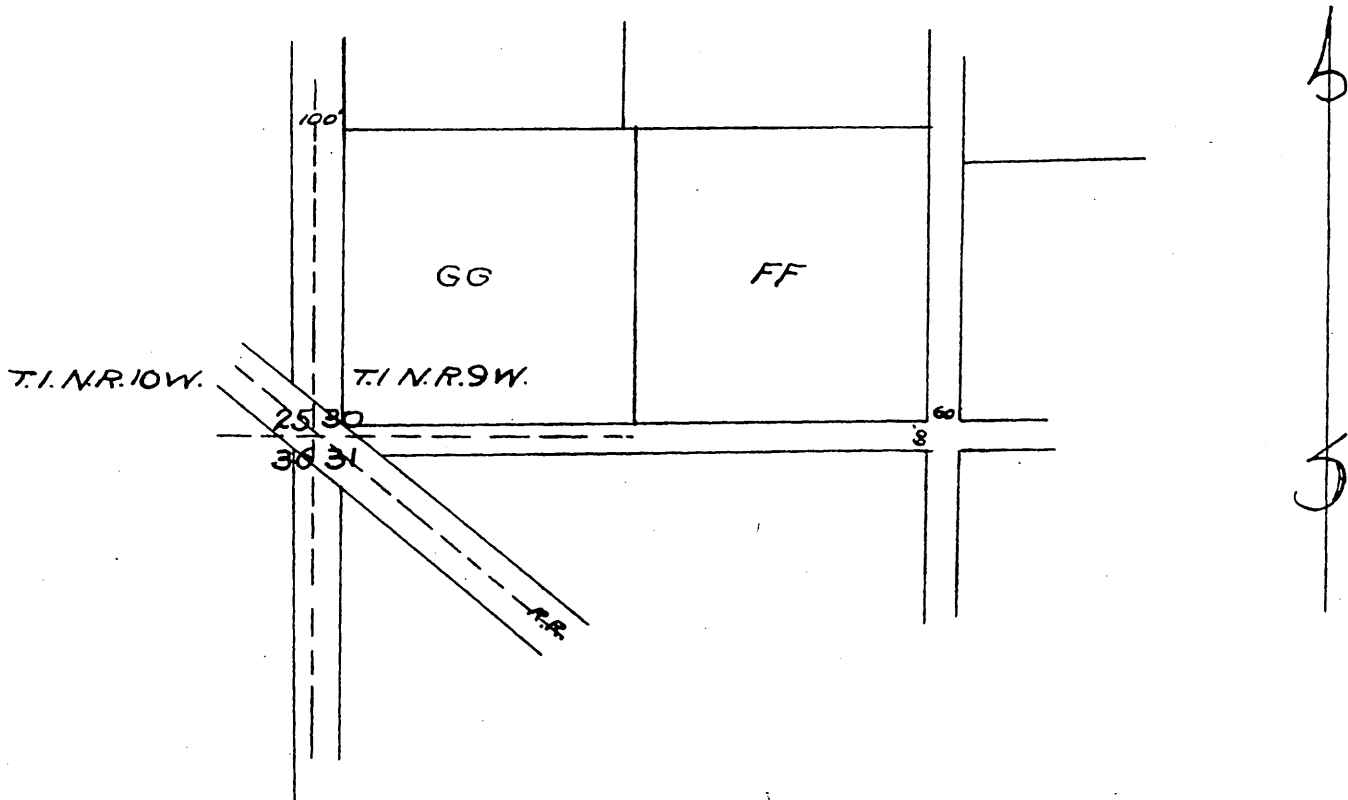

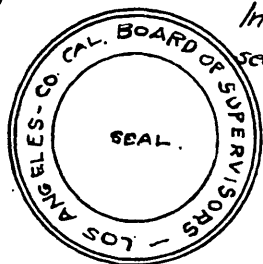
In re-Vacation of Highway  
Between Blocks FF and GG, Glendora Tract }  
Glendora Road District.

This being the time regularly set by order of this Board and publication of notice thereof for hearing the petition herein, the matter is called up and no protests having been filed. Upon motion of Supervisor Alexander duly seconded and carried it is ordered that that certain highway lying and being between Blocks FF and GG of the Glendora Tract according to map recorded in Book 15 pages 75 and 76, Misc Records of Los Angeles County lying between the north line of Minnehaha avenue in said Glendora Tract and the south line of the north half of the south west quarter of Section 30, Twp. 1. N.R. 9. W., S.B.M. be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage. This order is conditioned upon the petitioners filing for record in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County a certified copy hereof, together with a map showing all lands as affected thereby.
