and P.S. Wilson, and C.W. Bell, Clerk, by R. Williams Deputy

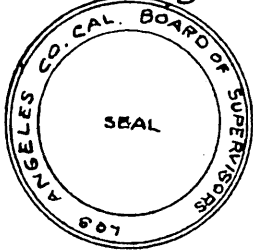
In re Vacation of Portion of

continuance of this Board for republication of notice of hearing herein, and pub-  
lication of said second notice, the matter is taken up, and M. F. Quinn, one of  
the petitioners herein is duly sworn and examined, and no protests having  
been filed; Upon motion of Supervisor Longden, duly seconded and car-  
ried, it is ordered that all that part of Second Street in Baldwin's Add-  
ition to El Monte, from the easterly line of El Monte Road to the westerly  
line of Tyler Street, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned,  
and the land therein contained restored to acreage. This order is conditioned up-  
on the filing for record in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles ---  
County of a certified copy hereof, together with a map showing all pro-  
perty as affected thereby.
