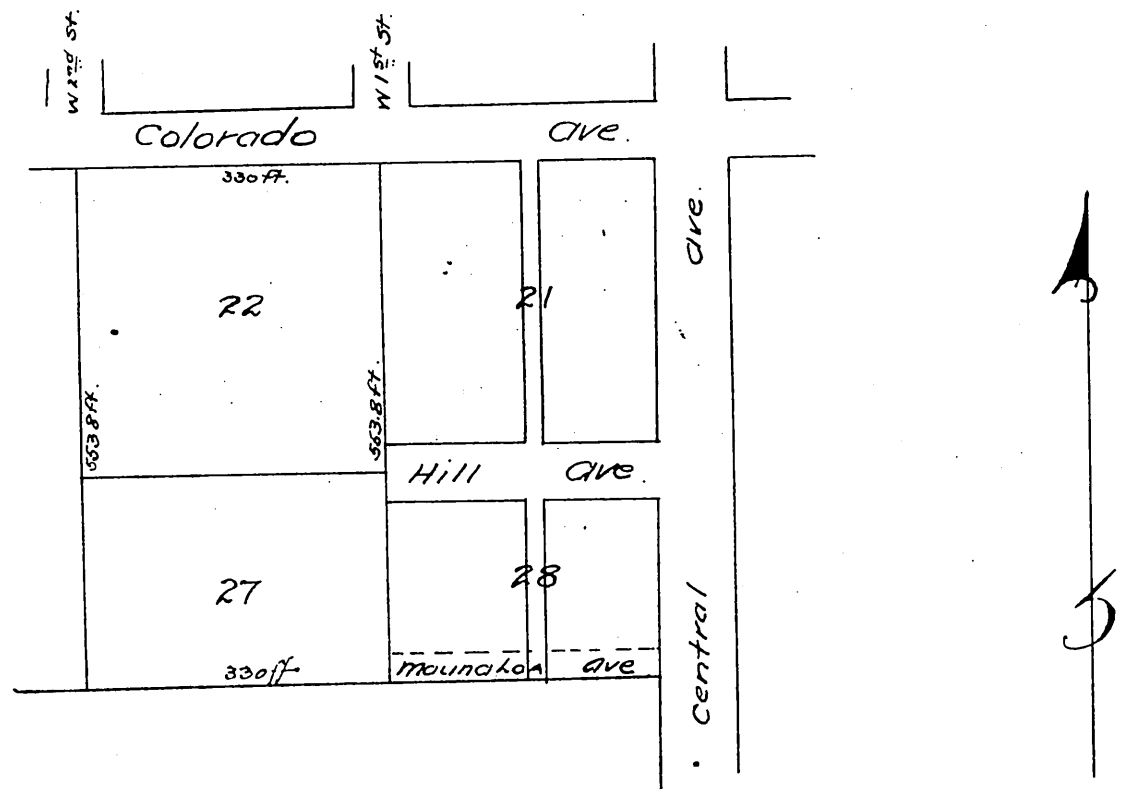

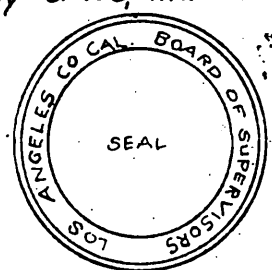

In re Vacation of a Portion of West First Street  
In the Le Mars Addition to the Town of  
Alosta, Glendora Road District.

This being the time regularly set by order of this Board and publication of notice thereof for hearing the petition herein, the matter is called up and no protests having been filed, upon motion of Supervisor Alexander, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that that portion of West First Street beginning at the south line of Colorado Avenue in the Le Mars Addition to the Town of Alosta, in Glendora Road District County of Los Angeles, State of California, as per map of said Le Mars Addition recorded in Book 52 page 57 of the miscellaneous records of said Los Angeles County, thence south to the north line of the south half of the southwest quarter of Section 31, Township 1 North, Range 9 West S. B. M.; be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage, this order is conditioned upon the petitioners filing for record in the office of the County Recorder of said Los Angeles County, a certified copy hereof together with a map showing all affected thereby.
