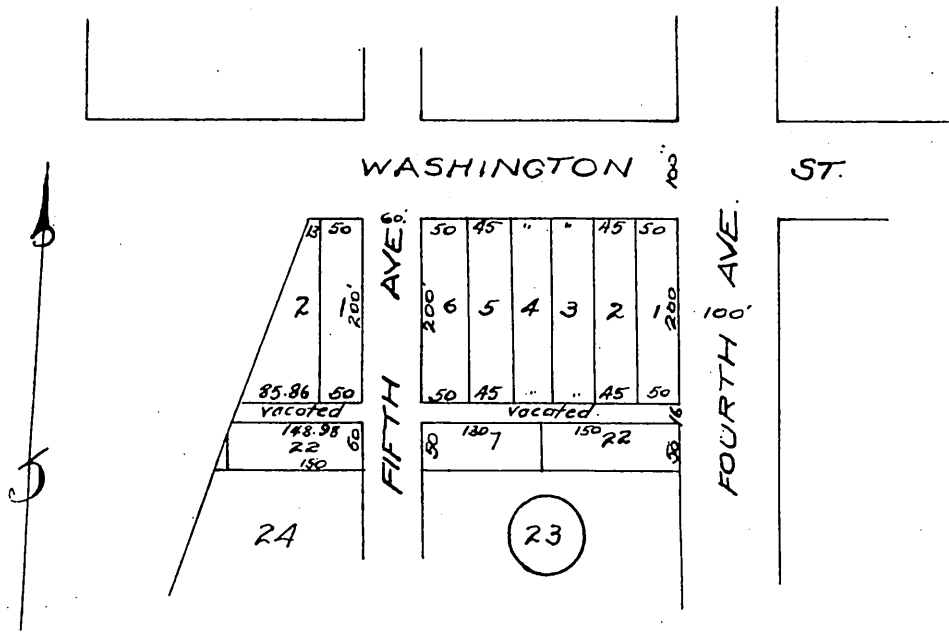


Map showing location of Alley vacated by the attached order of the Board of Supervisors in Blks. 23 and 24 Arlington Heights Tract.

In re Vacation of an Alley  
in Arlington Heights Tract.  
Petition of the Mc Carthy Co., et al.

This being the time regularly set by order of this Board and publication of notice thereof for hearing herein, the matter is called up, and no protests having been filed, Upon motion of Supervisor Wilson, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that that certain alley running from 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue west 280 feet to 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and from 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue west 142.98 feet, being 200 feet south of Washington street in Blocks 23 and 24, Arlington Heights Tract, as per map thereof recorded in Book 29, page 29 of the Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage. This order is conditioned upon the petitioners herein filing for record in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County a certified copy hereof, together with a map showing all property as affected thereby.
