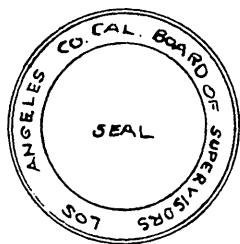
In re Vacation of First Street

in Block One (1) North Manhattan
Beach. Petition of Thomas S
Wadsworth, et al.

This being the time regularly set by order of this Board and publication of notice thereof for a hearing herein, the matter is called up and no protests having been filed, Upon motion of Supervisor Wilson duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that First Street from the northerly line of the Strand to the southerly line of Highland Avenue, lying between Blocks 1 and A North Manhattan Beach, also Highland Avenue from the easterly end thereof to the easterly side of Second Street, and also those certain alleys located in Block 1 of said North Manhattan Beach, - all as will appear more fully described by reference to a plat of said North Manhattan Beach recorded in Book 1, page 97 of Maps, in the Recorder's office of Los Angeles County, California, be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage. This order is conditioned on the petitioners filing for record in the office of the Recorder of Los Angeles County a certified copy hereof together with a map showing all property as affected thereby.
