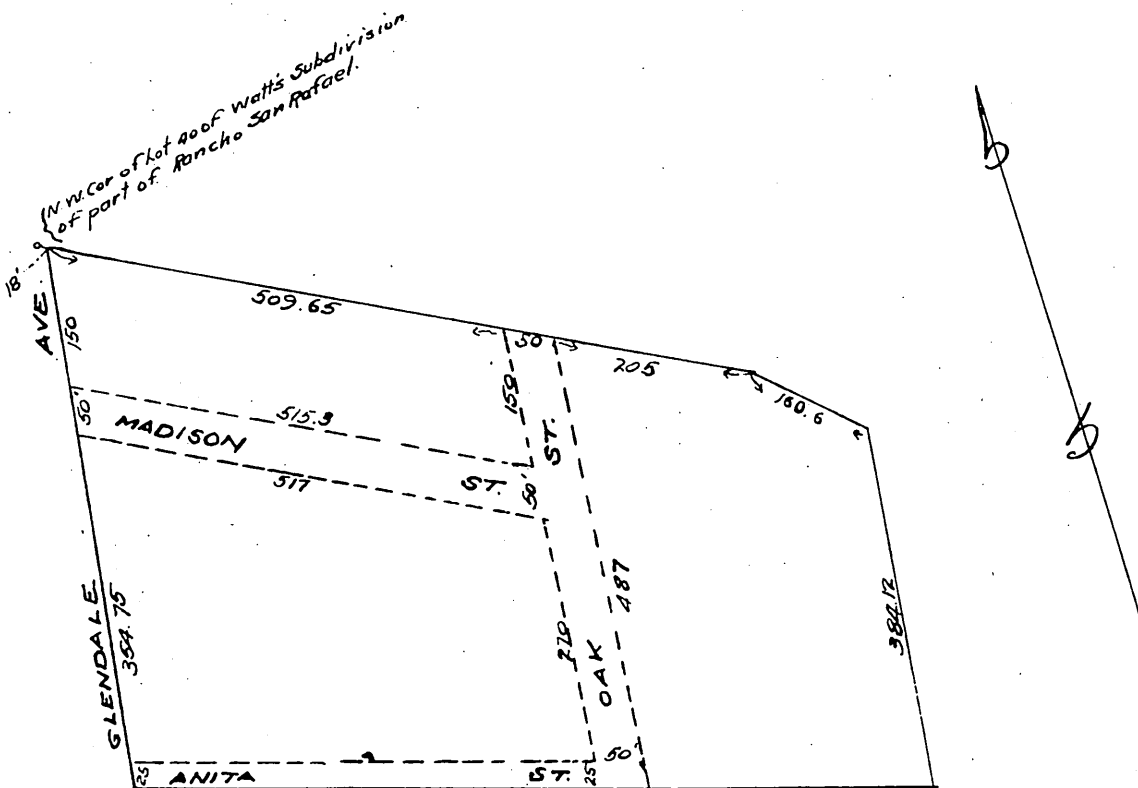


Map showing

The Board met in regular session. Present Supervisors O. W. Longden Chairman, presiding Geo. Alexander, A. J. Graham, C. E. Patterson and R. J. Wilson, and C. G. Keyes, Clerk, by J. O. Lowe, deputy.

This being the time regularly set by order of this Board, and publication of notice thereof, for hearing the petition herein, the matter is called up, and no protests having been filed, on motion of Supervisor Patterson, duly seconded and carried, it is Ordered that Madison Street, Oak Street, and Anita Street, in the Glendale Avenue Tract, Los Angeles Road District, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California as per map of said Tract recorded in Book 30, page 33 of the Miscellaneous Records of said Los Angeles County, be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage. This order is conditioned upon the petitioners filing for record in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County a certified copy hereof together with a map showing all lands affected thereby.

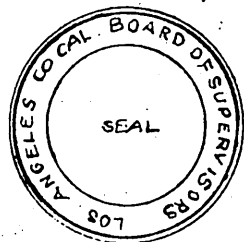
