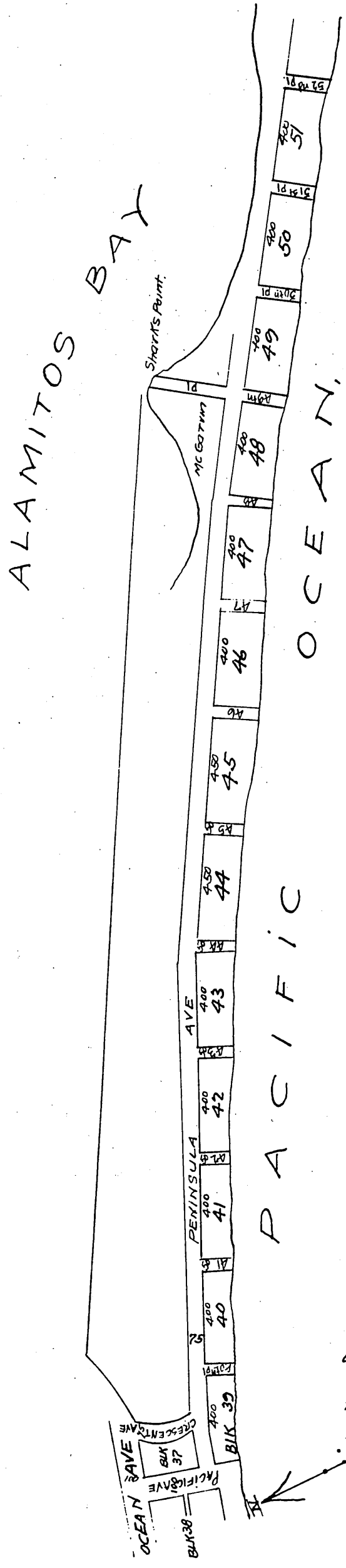


Plat of Part of

It is ordered that Peninsula Avenue, from the Southeastern line of Pacific Avenue to the Northwesterly line of 52nd Place, Alamitos Bay Townsite Long Beach Road District, County of Los Angeles, said Peninsula Avenue between said points running in a Northwesterly and Southeastern, direction, as per map of said Alamitos Bay Townsite, recorded in Book 55, page 62 et seq, Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage.
