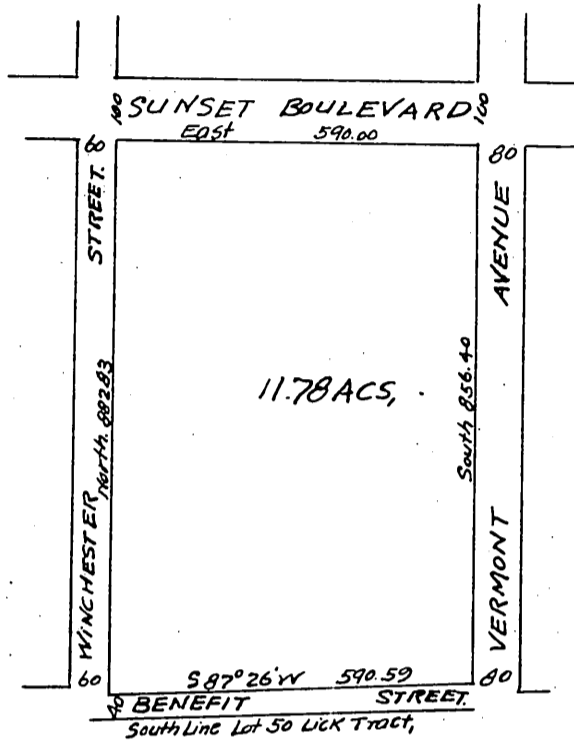


Map of

parallel to the present south line of Benefit Street, as shown on Map No 5331 in  
the office of the County Surveyor of Los Angeles County, be and the same is hereby  
vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage.
