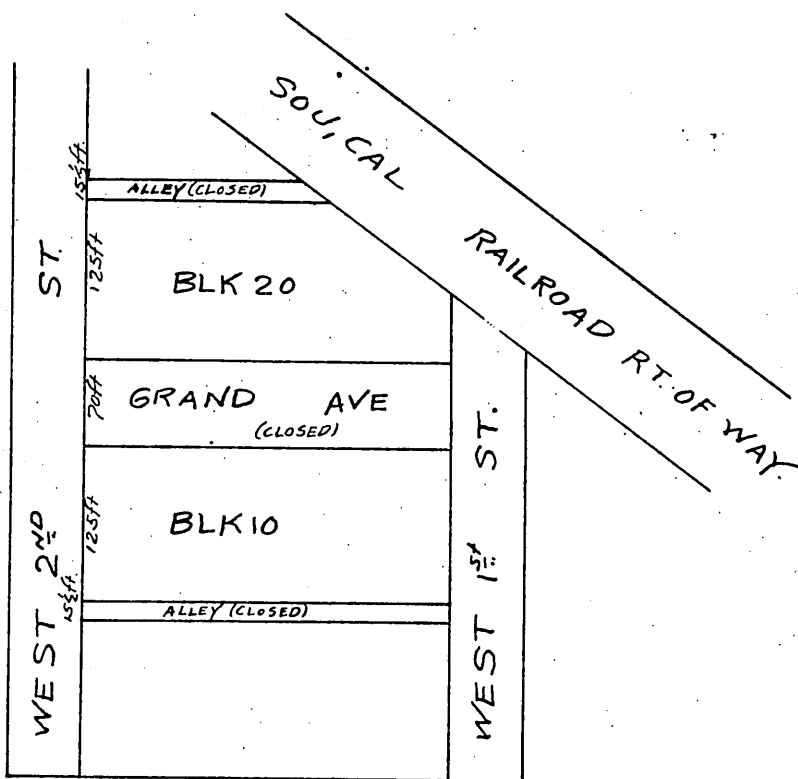

In re-vacation of a Portion of Grand Avenue
and certain Alleys in the Town of Alhata
Glendora Road District, Petition of B. R
Davissom et al,

it is ordered that that certain highway known as Grand Avenue
lying and being between Blocks 10 and 20 in the Town of Alhata, and also lying
between the westerly line of West First Street and the easterly line of West
Second Street, also that certain alley lying in Block 20 of the said Town of Alhata
lying between the Southwesterly line of, the right of way of the Southern Califor-
nia Railway Company and the easterly line of West Second Street, also the
Alley lying in Block 10 of the said Town of Alhata, lying between the westerly
line of West First Street and the easterly line of West Second Street, all in Glendora
Road District, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, as per map of
said Town of Alhata recorded in Book 16, at pages 21 and 22 of the Miscellaneous
Records of Los Angeles County, be and the same are hereby vacated and abandon-
ed and the land therein contained restored to acreage,
