A resolution refusing to accept an offer of dedication of a certain alley in Smiley and Scofield's Subdivision of South Pasadena, recorded in Miscellaneous Records Book Seventeen (17) Page eighty-three (83), Records of Los Angeles County.

Be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the City of South Pasadena that the offer to dedicate a certain alley which was made by the filing of a map of Smiley and Scofield's Subdivision, which said map is recorded in Book Seventeen (17) Page eighty-three (83), Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, State of California be and the same is hereby rejected, and this Board of Trustees hereby refuse to accept said alley as a public highway, said alley is more particularly described as follows, Being an alley fifteen (15) feet in width running Northerly two hundred and fourteen (214) feet from the Northerly line of Encino Avenue and lying immediately Westerly of the Westerly line of Lots One (1) Two (2) Three (3) and Four (4) of said Smiley and Scofield's Subdivision.
