ing between the south line of ocean Avenue and ordinary high tide of Pacific ocean,
said streets running in a general northerly and southerly direction, and also the
following strips of land lying between the south line of ocean Avenue and top edge
of the bluff in front of Block 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47 and 48 respectively, said strip
of land each running in a general easterly and westerly direction, all of the above
streets and strips of land lying and being in the Alamitas Beach, in Long Beach
Road District, County of Los Angeles, state of California as will more fully appear
