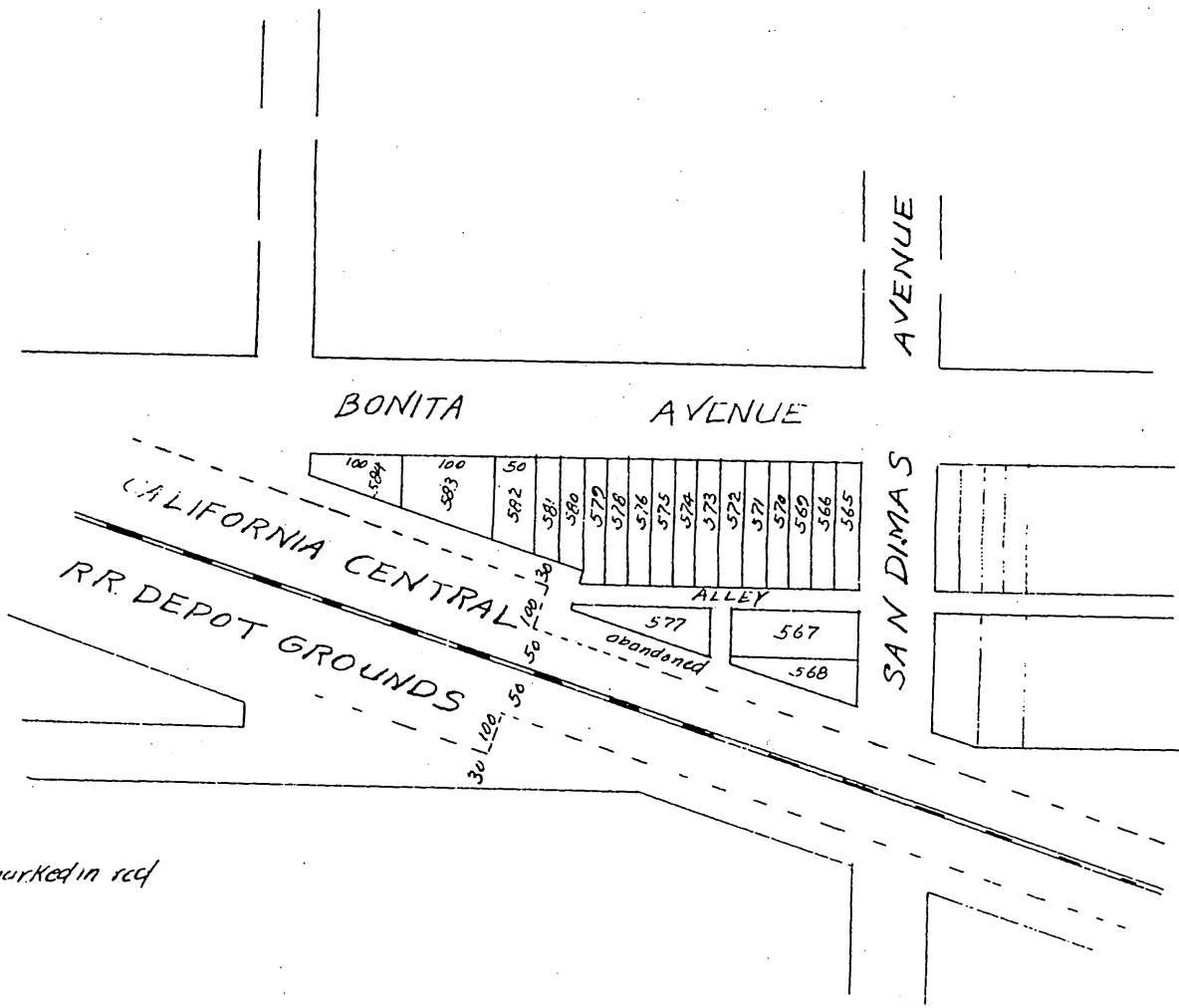


Part of the Map
