



trr(2), the northerly five (5) feet and the southerly five (5) feet of Alameda Street (leaving said Alameda Street forty (40) feet wide) the easterly fifteen (15) feet and the westerly fifteen (15) feet of that portion of Central Avenue lying south of Alameda Street (leaving such portion of Central Avenue fifty (50) feet wide) and that portion of Central Avenue lying north of Alameda Street, also the northerly ten (10) feet and the southerly ten (10) feet of Mission Avenue (leaving said portion of Mission Avenue forty (40) feet wide), also the alleys running easterly and westerly through Blocks A, B, C, D and E, as the same are shown on the map of the Southern Part of Huntington laid off by J. F. Torrell, being part of the Sierra Madre Villa Tract, recorded in Book 23, page 68, of Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, as will more fully appear by reference to map hereto attached and made a part hereof, be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage,

and is further conditioned upon petitioner conveying to the County of Los Angeles for road purposes Alameda Street and also Mission Avenue from the easterly side of Chestnut Avenue through Block E to the westerly boundary of the Southern part of Huntington,
