In ReVacation of Railroad Street,
Sunny Slope Avenue, Kinneyloo Avenue,
and Bicknell Avenue, Sierra Madre
Road District, Petition of James
Fritley et al;

The protests of A E Bryan
and 93 others, protesting against the vacation and abandonment of Railroad Street
from the East side of Sunny Slope Avenue to Chapman Ranch line, and of Sunny
Slope Avenue from Colorado Street to Railroad Street, and of Kinneyloo Avenue
from Colorado Street to Sierra Madre Street, is presented and read, and upon
motion of Supervisor Alexander, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that
said petition for the vacation and abandonment of said Avenues or public high
ways be and the same is hereby denied, except as to that portion of Bicknell
Avenue described as follows to wit Bicknell Avenue from its southern terminus to
the South line of Colorado Street, as same is shown on map of Serrall's Subdivi-
sion of Lot 2, Block 16 of Lamanda Park, recorded in Book 29, Page 88, Miscella-
neous Records of Said County of Los Angeles, and it is further ordered
that said above described portion of Bicknell Avenue be and the same is
hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to
acrecage.
