


Map

In Re Vacating of a Road set apart by the
Commissioners of the Estate of Albert
Romland Deceased in Spadra Road Dis-
trict, Petition of Geo. E. Cross et al.

it is ordered that all that certain public street, road
or highway located in the Spadra Road District, County of Los Angeles, state
of California, described as follows; to wit "Beginning at the County Road which
crosses the Southern Pacific Railroad about one - eight mile east of the Lureto
Depot, and running easterly along the Southern Pacific railroad right of way
on the South side, over the lands of Joseph Ferrero, Charles William Romland
Francis Albert Romland, and Josephine Cross, said road having been set
apart by the Commissioners of the Estate of Albert Romland (Deceased)
at the time of the division of said estate, As will more fully appear by ref-
erence to a map hereto attached and made a part hereof " be and the-
same is hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contain-
ed restored to acreage,
