

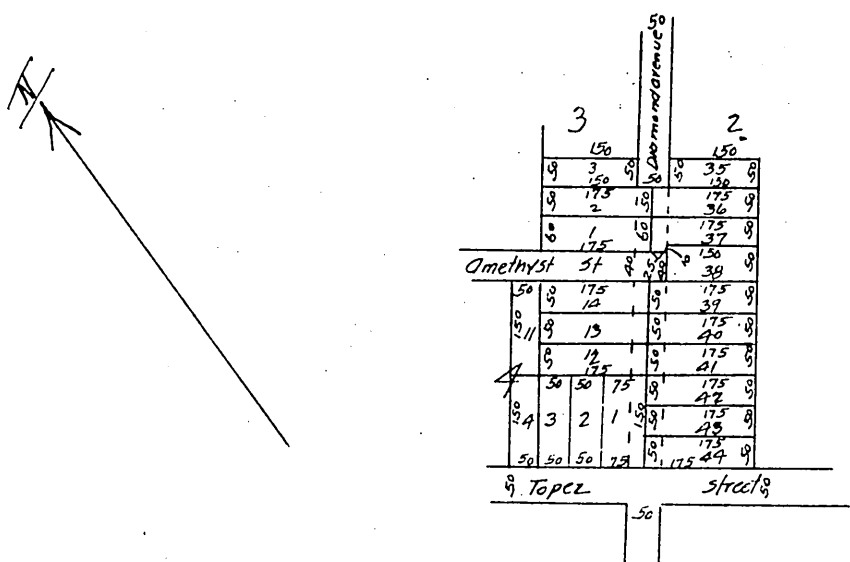

It is ordered that Diamond Avenue from the northerly line of Topaz Street to the southerly line of Amethyst Street, also Diamond Avenue from the northerly line of Amethyst Street to the southeasterly prolongation of north line of Lot 2, Block 3, Yorba and Paige Tract as shown upon a Map of said Tract recorded in Book 24, Page 56 Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, and located in the Alhambra Road District in said County, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage, Conditioned however, upon the petitioners herein deeding to the County of Los Angeles for road purposes certain property located in said Yorba and Paige Tract as set forth and described in the petition for vacation on file in the office of this Board,
