



according to the Map of Subdivisions of the Baugh Tract, recorded in Book 9, of page 23 (which street is also known as Kenneth Street) which was subsequently extended over the S. E. corner of Lot 3, said Hunter's Subdivision, and particularly located and defined by an official survey thereof, shown by Map numbered 3535, and the Field Notes relating thereto, on file in the County Surveyor's office, thence N. 81° 30' W. parallel to and sixty (60) feet from the northerly line of said Baugh Street 488.88 feet to intersect the southerly line of the second course of the public road or street lying along the North lines of said Lot 4, Hunter's Subdivision, thence along such northerly lines of the original Lot 4 afore said, viz. S. 63° E, about ninety-four and <sup>50</sup>/<sub>100</sub> (94.50 feet, and S. 81° 30' E 401.28 feet to point of beginning, courses and distances being derived from those of Records, said strip being the southerly half of the street or roadway as laid out lying along the northerly front of Lot four (4) of Hunter's Subdivision of part of the Rancho San Rafael, as shown on map thereof recorded in Book 5 page 395, Miscellaneous Records of said County" - be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage,
