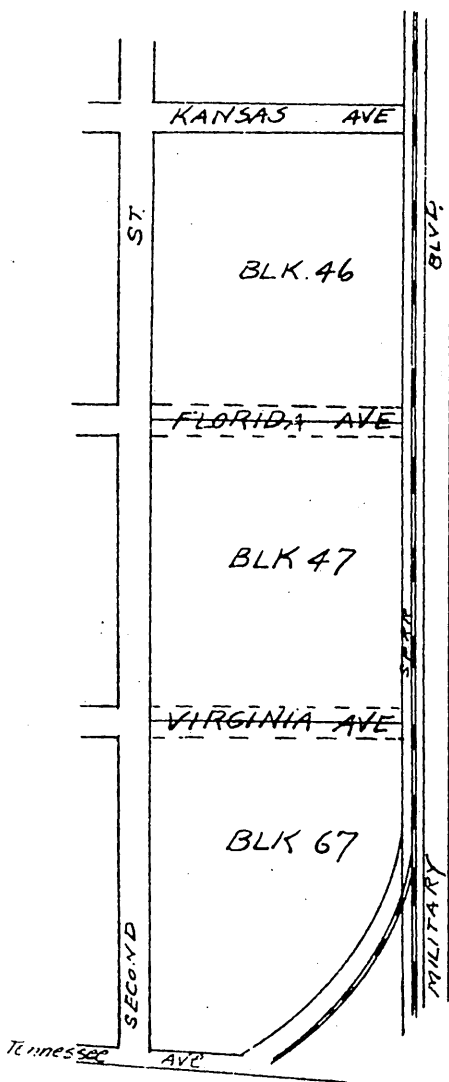

It is ordered that all those certain Streets situate in the Town of Santelle, Santa Monica Road District, County of Los Angeles, State of California, described as follows, to wit, Being in the Town of Santelle, in said Road District, in the Pacific Farms, as per Map thereof recorded in Map Book 1, Pages 43 and 44, in the office of the County Recorder of said Los Angeles County, and more particularly described as follows, The Eastern end of Florida Avenue, from Second Street East to the right-of-way of the Southern Pacific Railroad Company, The Eastern end of Virginia Avenue from Second Street East to the Right-of-way of the Southern Pacific Railroad Company" be and the same are here by vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage,
