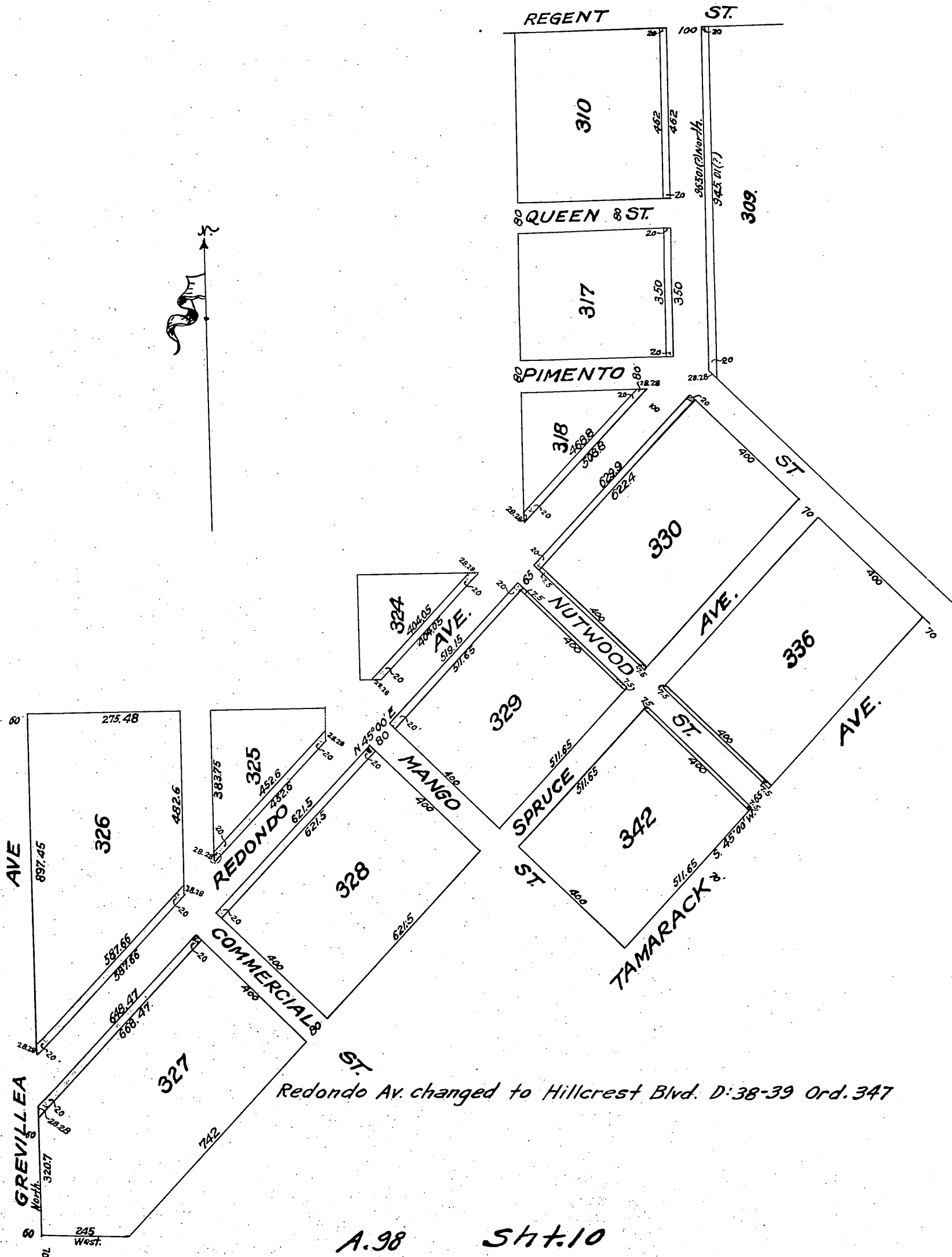

In re Vacation of Redondo Avenue and  
Nutwood Street in the Townsite of  
Inglewood, Centinela Road District  
Petition of John Aerick et. al.

It is ordered  
that all those portions of certain streets located in the Centinela Road District, County  
of Los Angeles, State of California, and described as follows, to-wit:  
The easterly and westerly twenty (20) feet of Redondo Avenue as said Avenue  
is shown on a "Plat of the Townsite of Inglewood" recorded in Book 34, pages 19-36  
of the Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, except such portions as  
may lie in the intersections of other public highways, also the northerly and  
southerly seven  $\frac{1}{2}$  ( $1\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet of Nutwood Street as shown on said "Plat of the Town  
site of Inglewood" from the easterly line of Redondo Avenue to the westerly line  
of Tamarack Avenue, except such portions as may lie in the intersections of other  
public highways, - are hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein  
contained restored to acreage.
