

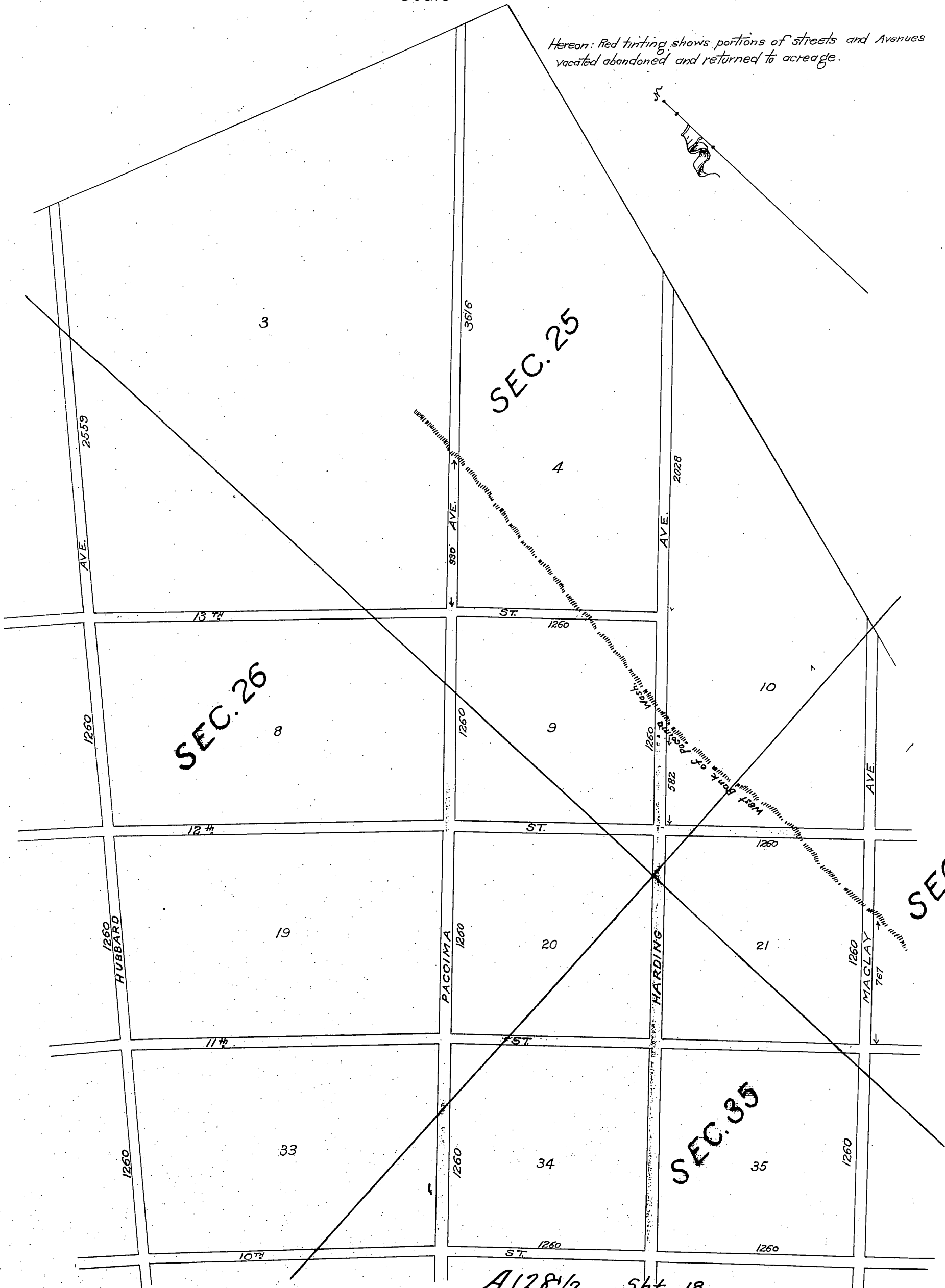

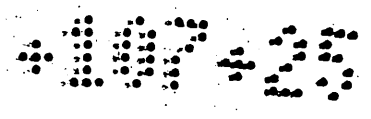

In Re-Vacation of Pacoima Avenue, Harding
Avenue, 11th Street, 12th Street and 13th St.
reet, in San Fernando Road Dist. Petition
of T.J. Walker et al.

It is ordered
that all those portions of the following described public highways situate in
the County of Los Angeles, State of California, to-wit, - (1) Pacoima Avenue, from
the North line of 10th Street to its intersection with the Pacoima Wash; (2) Harding Ave-
nue, from the North line of 10th Street to the intersection of said Harding Avenue with
the Pacoima Wash; (3) 11th Street, from Hubbard Avenue to Maclay Avenue; (4)
12th Street, from Hubbard Avenue to the intersection of said 12th Street with the Pa-
coima Wash; (5) 13th Street, from Hubbard Avenue to the intersection of said 13th
Street with the Pacoima Wash; be and the same are hereby vacated and abandon-
ed and the land therein contained restored to acreage, provided however that
this Board reserves the right of access to, and the right to remove gravel from
the gravel pit, which is located on Street, in said District.
