

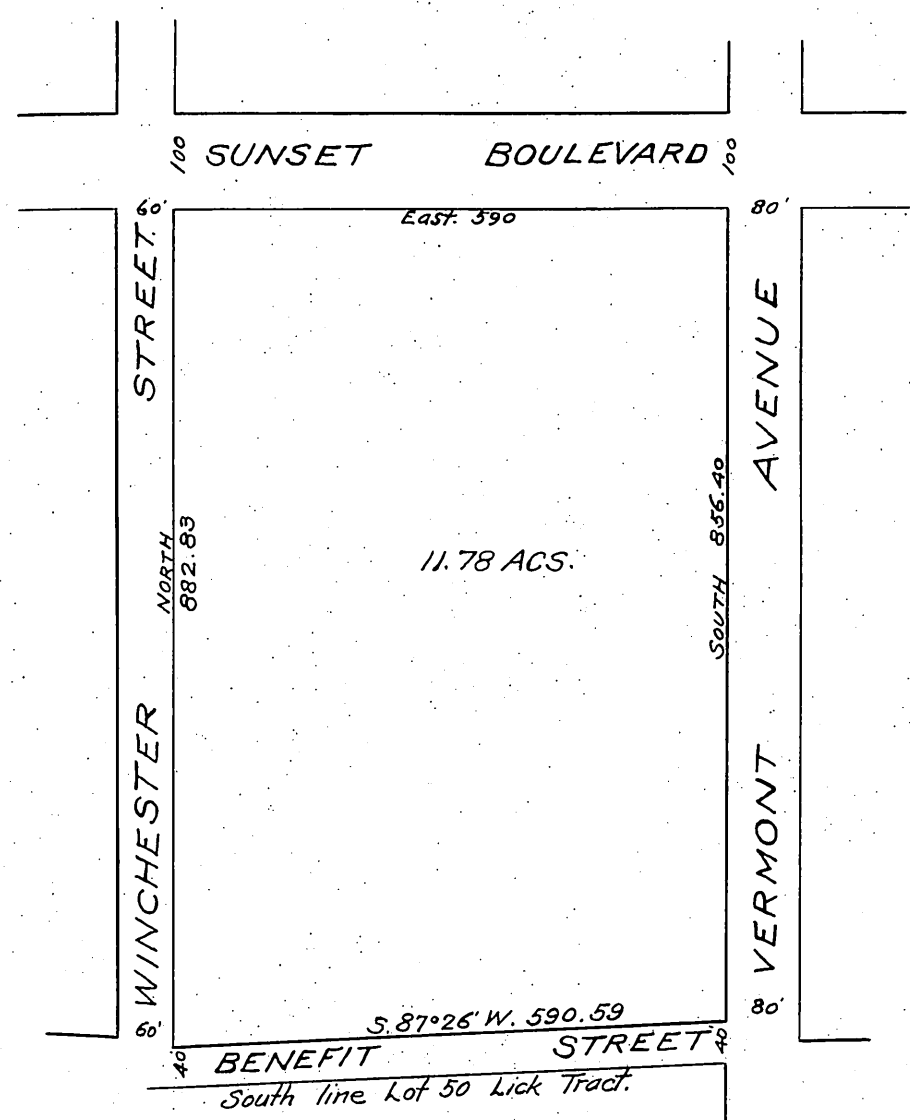
Map of

In re Vacation of a Portion of Benefit Street, Cahuenga Valley Road District.

it is ordered that the following described portion of Benefit Street, situate, lying and being in the Cahuenga Valley Road District, County of Los Angeles, State of California, to-wit: "That portion of Benefit Street between Vermont Avenue and Winchester St, lying north of a line drawn forty (40) feet from and parallel to the present south line of Benefit Street aforesaid, as shown on the County Surveyor's Map No. 5331" be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage.
