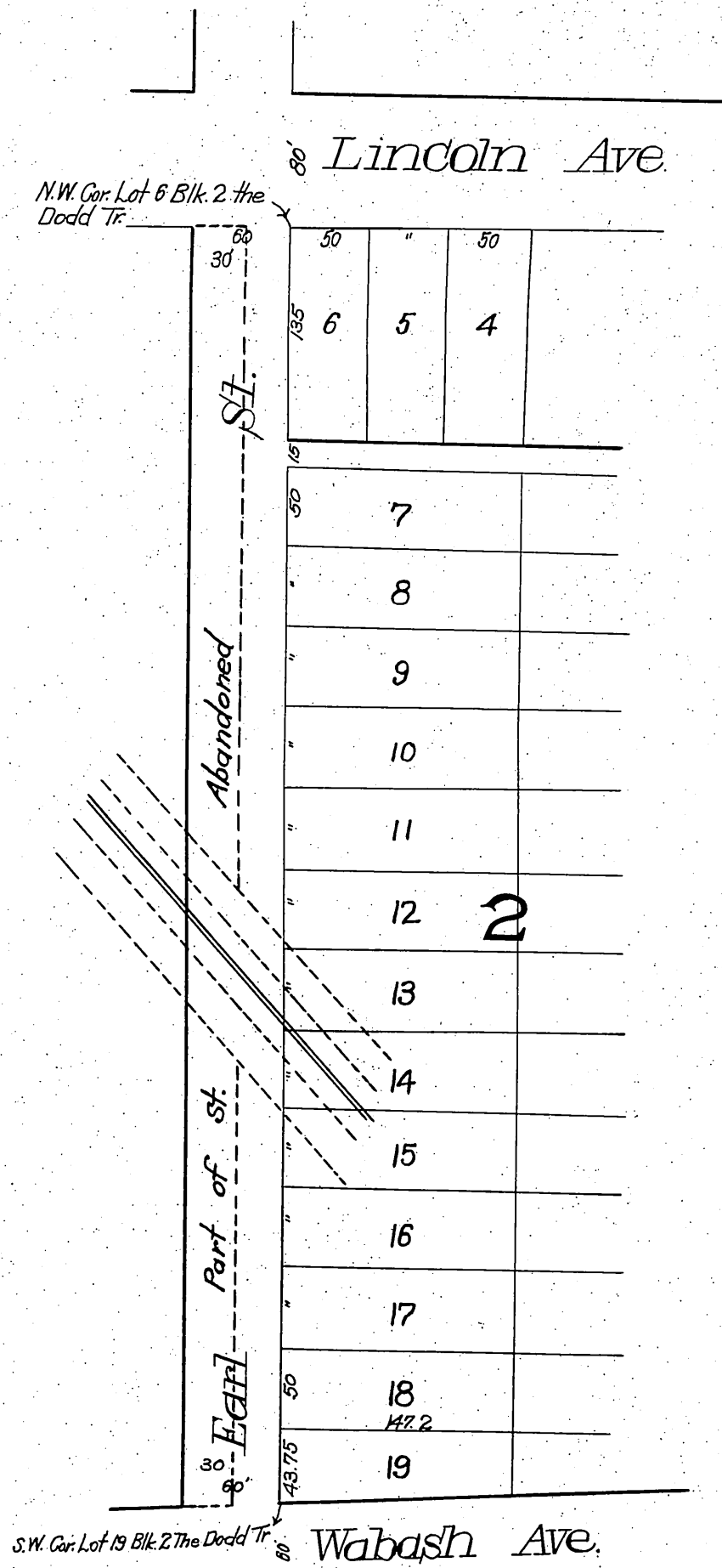
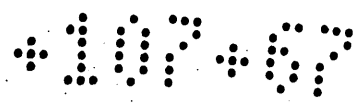


*Plat Showing Part of

In revocation of a portion of Earl St.
Cahuenga Valley Road District. }

It is ordered that the following described portion of Earl Street, ^{situate} lying and being in the Cahuenga Valley Road District, County of Los Angeles, State of California, to wit: Beginning at a point in the southerly line of Lincoln Avenue as shown on Map of the Dodd Tract, recorded in Book 23, page 86, of Miscellaneous Records of said County, distant 30 feet westerly from the North west corner of lot 6 in Block 2 of said Tract; thence southerly parallel with the westerly line of said Block to the northerly line of Wabash Avenue; thence westerly along the westerly prolongation of the southerly line of lot 19 in said Block to the westerly line of Earl Street; thence northerly along said line of Earl Street to its intersection with the southerly line of Lincoln Avenue; thence easterly 30 feet to the point of beginning. Excepting therefrom those portions included in the lines of New Sunset Boulevard, as shown on Map of East Hollywood Heights, recorded in Book 5, page 12, of Maps in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County, and as indicated on the attached map, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage.
