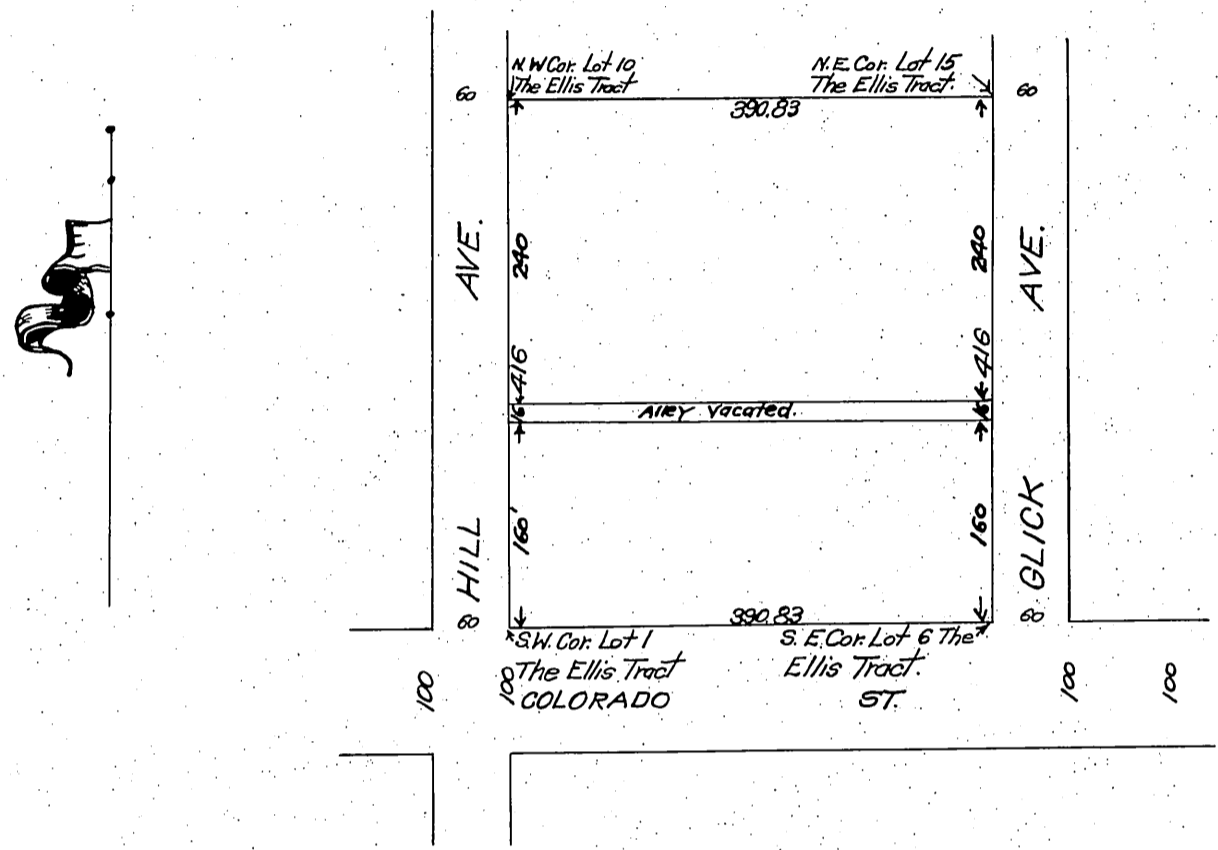


Showing the return to acreage of Lots 1 to 10 and 15 to 18 inclusive of the Ellis Tract,

In re-Vacation of an Alley running from Hill Avenue to Glick Avenue in the Ellis Tract, Sierra Madre Road District:

Office of the Board of Supervisors of Los Angeles County, California, Monday, August 28, 1905.

It is ordered that that certain Alley at present lying along the rear of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 of the Ellis Sub-division, being W. G. Benedict's Sub. of the West 6.06 Acres of the 9.56 Acres, deeded by Franklin F. Stetson to Joseph M. Ellis, recorded in Book 106, Page 128, Records of Los Angeles County, and running between Hill and Glick Avenues, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage.
