In revocation of Portion of Workman Mill Road, Los Nietos Road District.

This being the time regularly set by order of continuance for hearing the petition herein of C.S. Sanderson, et

al., for the vacation and abandonment of a portion of the Old Workman Mill Road, the matter is called up, and the Clerk of this Board reporting that the required affidavit of publication of notice of hearing herein has been filed, and no protests having been filed upon motion of Supervisor Alexander, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that all that portion of the Old Workman Mill Road situate, lying and being in the Los Nietos Road District, County of Los Angeles, State of California, and described as follows-to wit "All that portion of the Old Workman Mill Road in Lot 7 of Cohn's partition of Lots 26, 27, 29 and 32 of the partition had in Case No 20613, Superior Court, Los Angeles County, California, as per Map recorded in Book 60, Pages 3 and 4, Misc. Records, Los Angeles Co., being west of the West line of the present County road as described and shown upon Map in Deed recorded in Deed Book 1723 Page 245, Records of Los Angeles County;" be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage.
