H is ordered that the following described bublic highways situate, lying and being in the Redondo Road District, Gunty of Los Angeles, State of California, to wit; In Shakespeare Beach: - All of Byron Street; all of Burns-Street; all of Romeo Street; all of Juliet Street; all of Keats Street lying Fast of the intersection of Juliet Street; all of Desdemona Place except that part of the Westerly 85 feet of said Desdemona Place adjoining hot 32, Block 5, Shakespeare Beach and lying Northerly from a line beginning at the North westerly corner of said Lot 32, Block 5, and running in an easterly direction 85 feet at right angles to stratford Avenue (the intention being to make Lot 32, Black 5, Shakespeare Beach, 36 feet wide for its entire length, and to allow a new 40 foot straight street to be run at right angles to stratford Avenue be-tween the Westerly lines of Lot-5 in Block 6 and Lot 32 in Block 5). In Manhattan Beach: — All of the Alley lying between Lot II and Lots 12,13,14,15, and 16 in Block I, and that part of the Alley lying between Lots 3 and 11 in Block I, situate 120 feet Southerly from the Southerly line of First Street, Manhattan Beach" be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage.
