It is ordered that the following described public highways to wit:
All of the Streets and Avenues shown on the map of East Pasadena, recorded in Book 29, Page
4, Miscellaneous Records of said County, lying north of the North line of Colorado Street and
west of the West line of Allen Avenue, being more particularly described as follows: All of Foun-
tain Street and all of Fleming, Modina, Compton and Lyman Avenues, as shown on the Map
of East Pasadena herein before referred to, said streets and avenues lying in the Sierra Madre
Road District, County of Los Angeles, State of California, be and the same are hereby vacated
and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage.
