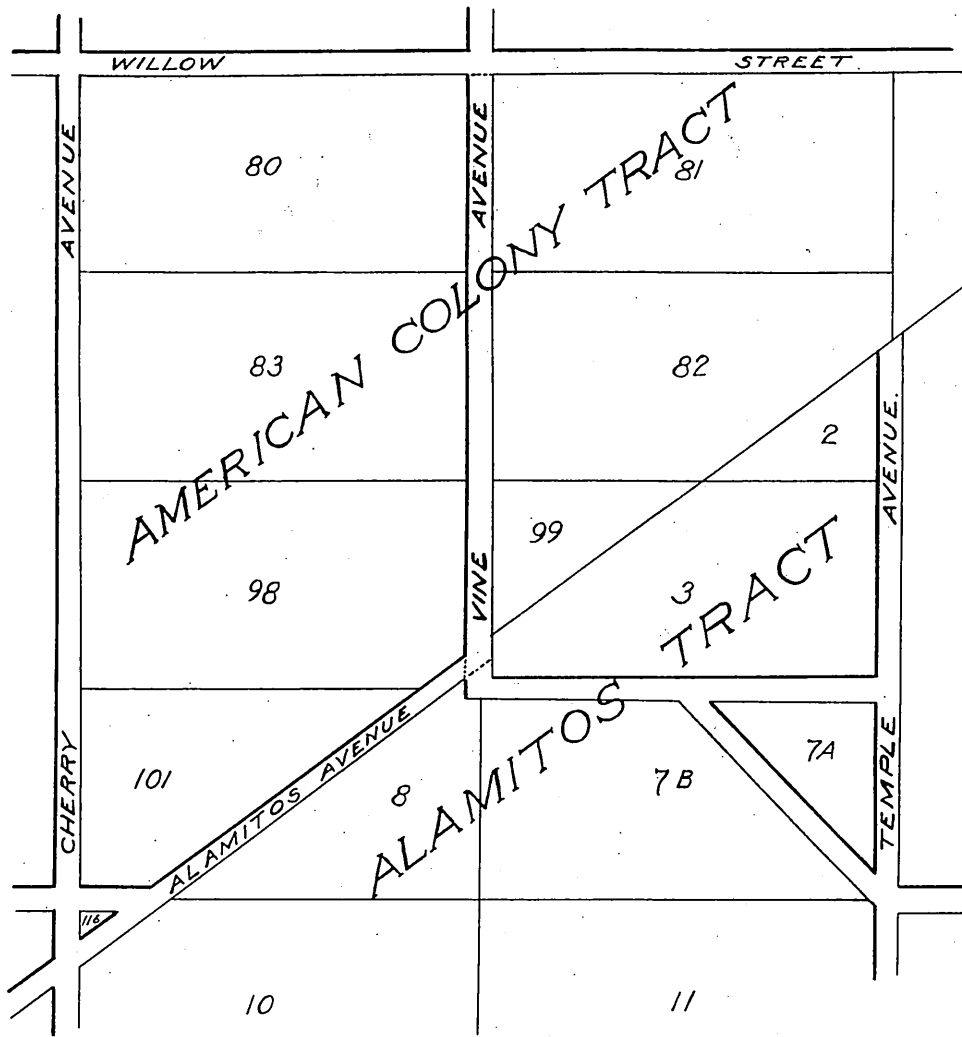

It is ordered, that all that portion of Vine Avenue in the Long Beach Road District, County of Los Angeles, State of California, described as follows to-wit: "All that portion of Vine Avenue commencing at its intersection with Alamos Avenue, as shown on that certain Map of the Alamos Tract recorded in Book 36, page 37 et seq, Miscellaneous Records of the County of Los Angeles, and running to the South line of Willow Street as shown on Map of the American Colony Tract recorded in Book 19, page 89, et seq, Miscellaneous Records of the County of Los Angeles," be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage.
