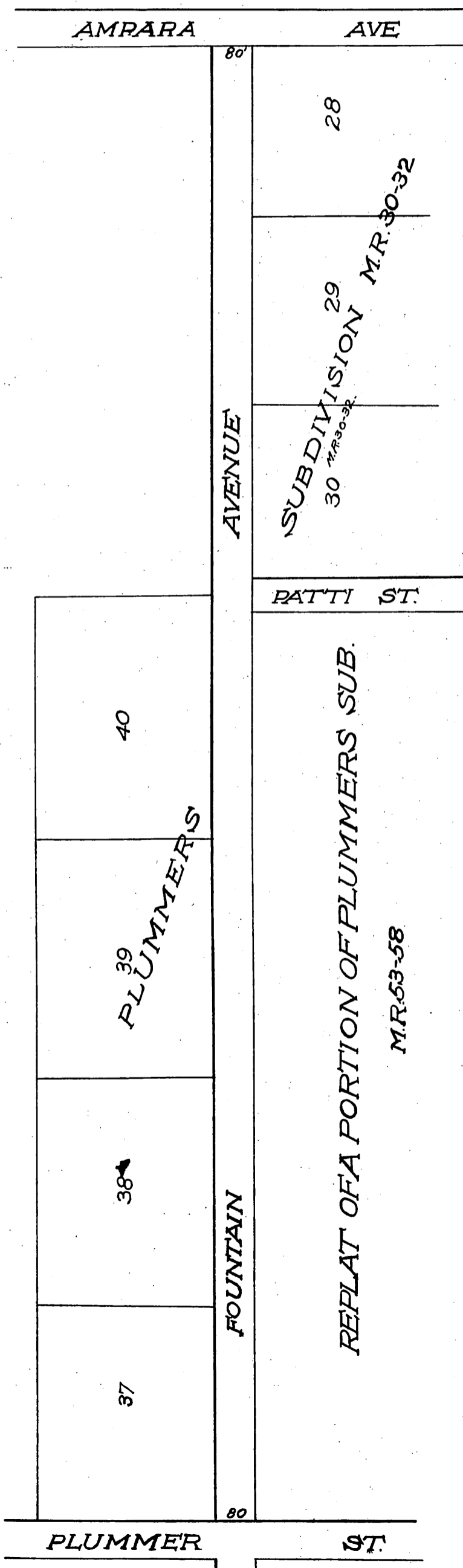
FOUNTAIN AVENUE

It is ordered that the petition of the So. Cal. Real Estate Investment Co., et al., for the vacation and abandonment of all that part of Fountain Avenue between Plummer Street on the East and Ampara Street on the West, said portion of said Fountain Avenue being situate in the Cahuenga Valley Road District, County of Los Angeles, State of California, be and the same is hereby granted, and all that portion of that certain public highway described as follows, to wit: "All that portion of Fountain Avenue between Plummer Street on the East, and Ampara Street on the West," is hereby declared to be vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage.
