
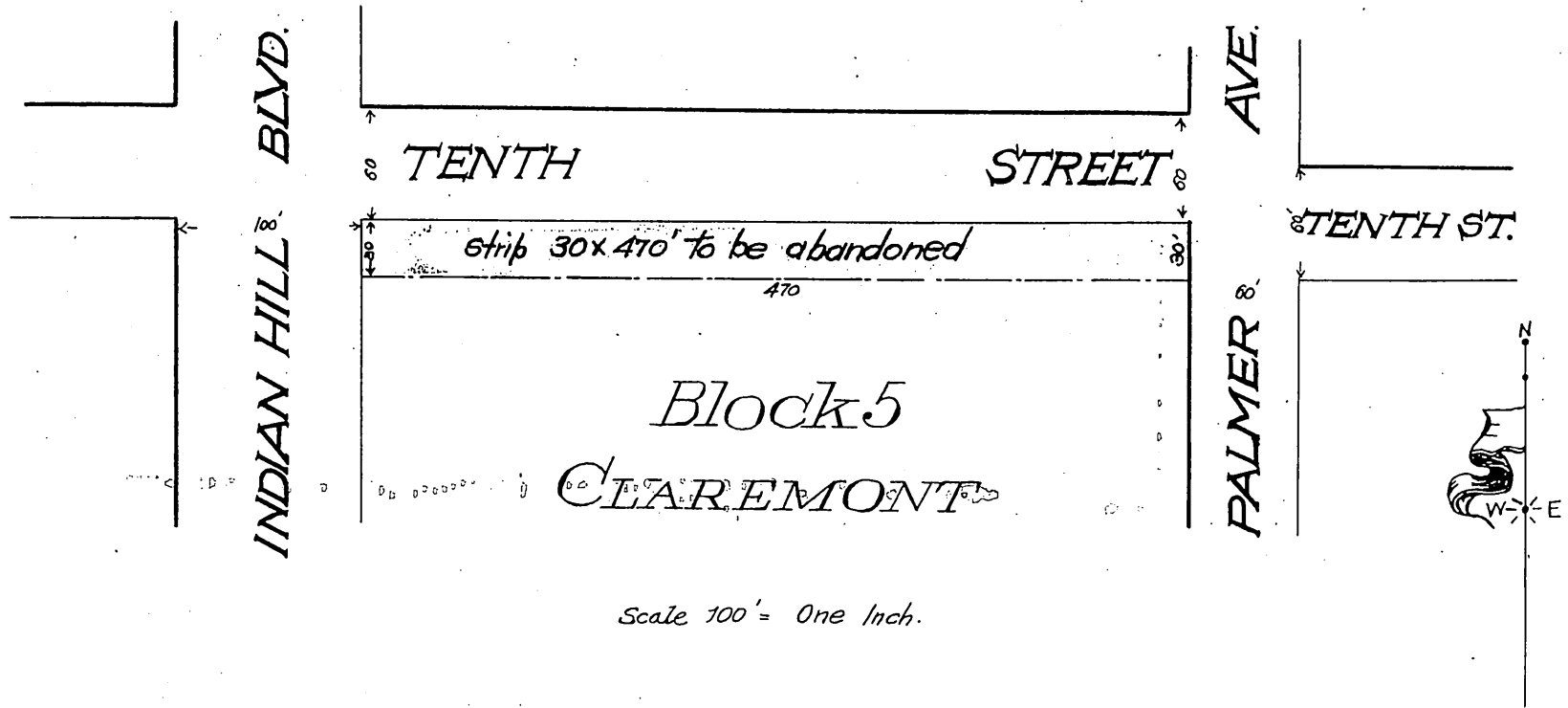

In Re-Vacation of a portion of Tenth  
 Street in the Town of Claremont }  
 San Jose Road District.

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Block 5, as the same is shown upon the Map of the Town of Claremont, recorded in Book 15, pp 87 & 88 Miscellaneous Records in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County, State of California, and running thence West--a uniform width of thirty (30) feet--along and adjoining the North line of said Block 5, a distance of 470 feet to the east line of a public road known as Indian Hill Boulevard. Being the south one-half of said Tenth Street shown upon the map aforesaid." the matter is called up, and no protests having been filed, upon motion of Supervisor Brady, duly seconded and carried, it is ordered that said petition be and the same is hereby granted, the land hereinabove described restored to acreage.
