

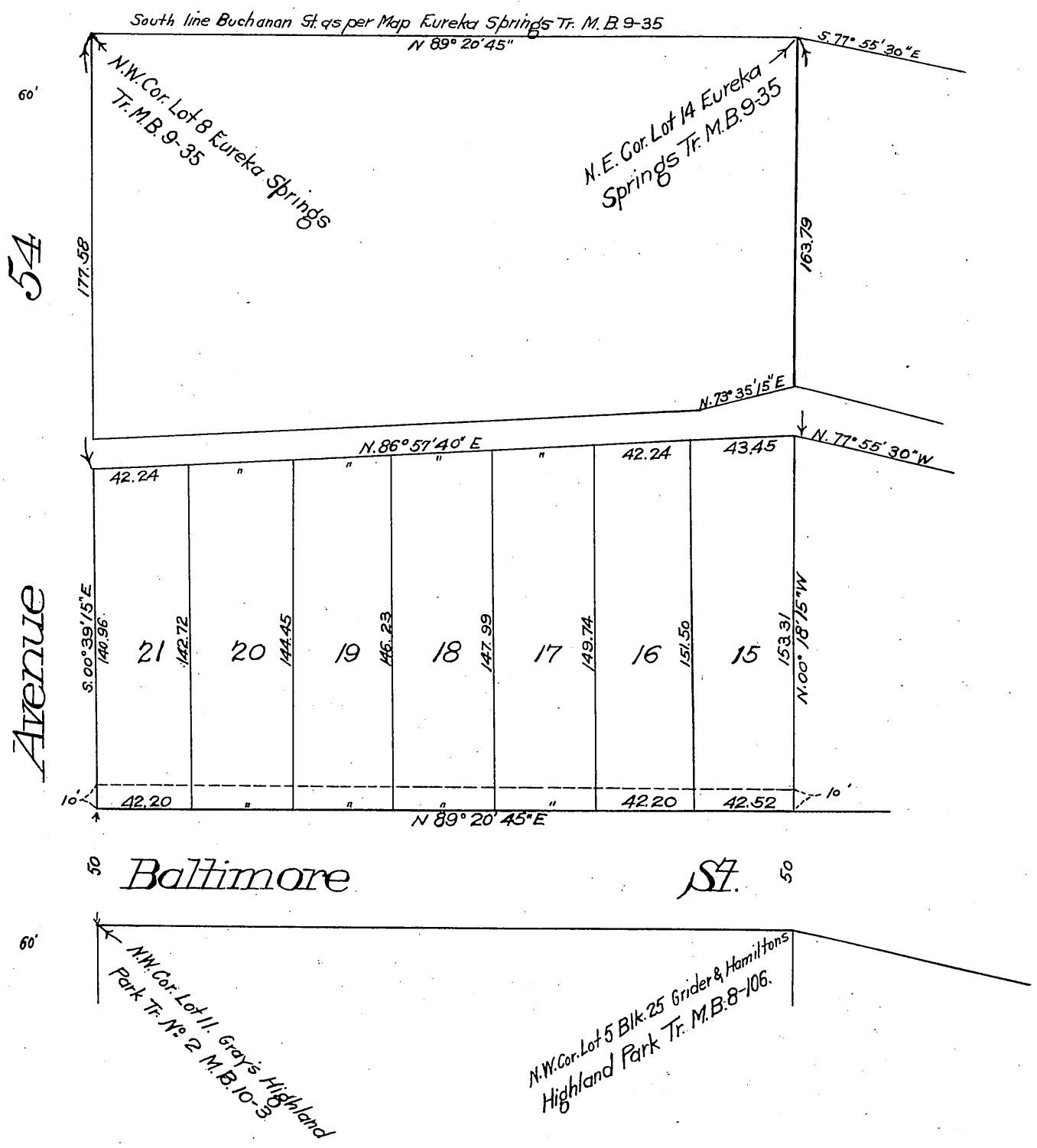

It is ordered that said petition be and the same is hereby granted, and that the following described portion of Baltimore Street, situate, lying and being in the Los Angeles Road-District, County of Los Angeles, State of California, to-wit: A strip of land of the uniform width of 10 feet off the North side of a certain portion of Baltimore Street, more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 8, Block 17 of Grider & Hamilton's Highland Park, as per Map recorded in Book 8 of Maps, Page 106, Records of Los Angeles County, California; said point of beginning being also the Southeast corner of Lot 15 of Eureka Springs Tract, as per map recorded in Book 9 of Maps, page 35, records of Los Angeles County, California; thence S. 89° 20' 45" W along the north line of Baltimore Street, as dedicated by said map of Eureka Springs Tract, 295.72 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 21 of said Eureka Springs Tract; thence S. 0° 39' 15" E 10 feet to a point; thence N. 89° 20' 45" E parallel and 10 feet distant from said North line of Baltimore Street 341.20 to the point of intersection with the North line of Baltimore Street, as per said map of Grider and Hamilton's Highland Park; thence South easterly in a direct line to the point of beginning; be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned and the land therein contained restored to acreage.
