

In Revocation of Byron Street and
other streets in Redondo Road
District }

Office of the Board of Supervisors
of Los Angeles County, California
Tuesday, August 21, 1906.

It is
ordered that the following described public highways situate, lying and being
in the Redondo Road District, County of Los Angeles, State of California, to-wit: —
In Shakespeare Beach: All of Byron Street; All of Burns Street; all of Romeo Street; all
of Juliet Street; all of Keats Street lying east of the westerly line of Juliet Street
prolonged southerly; all of Desdemona Place except that part of the westerly 85
feet of said Desdemona Place adjoining Lot 32, Block 5 Shakespeare Beach and lying
northerly from a line beginning at the northwesterly corner of said Lot 32 Block 5,
and running in an easterly direction 85 feet at right angles to Stratford Avenue (the
intention being to make Lot 32, Block 5, Shakespeare Beach, 36 feet wide for its
entire length and to allow a new 40 foot straight street to be run at right angles
to Stratford Avenue between the westerly lines of Lot 5 in Block 6 and Lot 32 in
Block 5, Shakespeare Beach); In Manhattan Beach: All of the Alley lying between
Lot 11 and Lots 12, 13, 14, 15 & 16 in Block 1; and all that part of the alley lying between
Lots 3 and 11 in Block 1, situate 120 feet southerly from the southerly line of First -
Street, Manhattan Beach: -- be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned
and the land therein contained restored to acreage.
