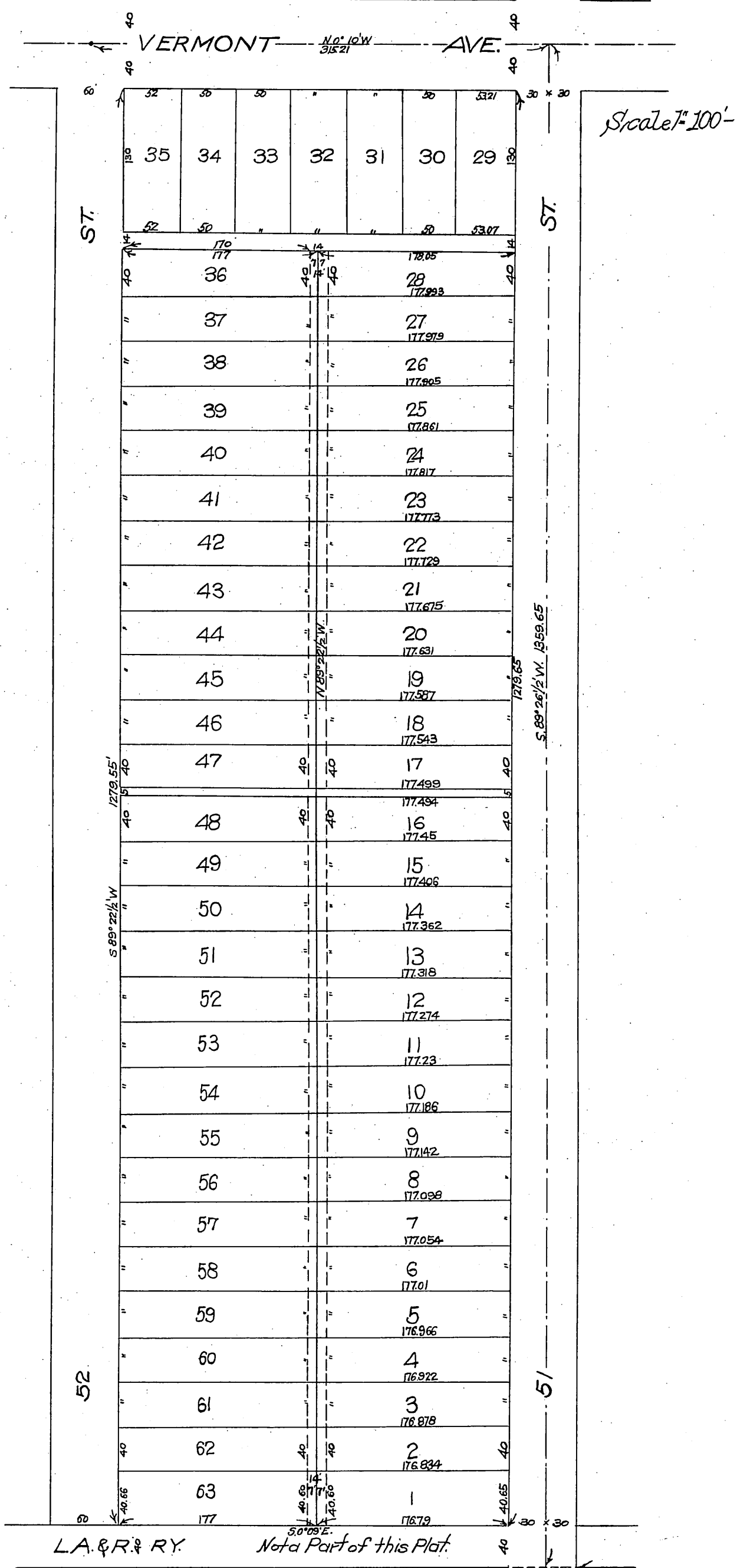

In Revocation of Alleys in Green }
Meadows Road District. }

It is ordered that the following described alleys, situate, lying and being in the Green Meadows Road District, County of Los Angeles, State of California, to-wit: That certain alley running parallel to Fifty-first (51st) Street from Redondo Avenue to Vermont Avenue, and being between Fifty-first and Fifty-second streets; also, that certain alley between Redondo Avenue and Vermont Avenue and running north and south from Fifty-first to Fifty-second Street, and being distant about one hundred forty (140) feet east of Vermont Avenue, be and the same are hereby vacated and abandoned and the lands therein contained restored to acreage.
